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2024 Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (BRIC) Announcement

The State of Alaska DHS&EM & the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) are excited to announce the 2024 BRIC Grant Funding opportunity. This communication is to inform eligible stakeholders interested in submitting update community Hazard Mitigation Plans (HMPs) and develop mitigation projects. The formal Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) will be published by FEMA in the late summer, but entity leadership and community members should begin assessing their respective HMPs, roads, public buildings, and other critical infrastructure where mitigation actions are intended to occur. This will allow more time to plan and develop project sub applications. It is encouraged that submitted mitigation projects reflect mitigation strategies in exiting Hazard Mitigation Plans (HMPs). An eligible stakeholder must

The eligible level of government (city, tribe, borough, etc.) will be referred to as the <u>Sub applicant</u> once a *Notice of Interest (NOI)* is submitted to the State, the State will be referred to as the <u>Applicant</u>. The sooner an entity has worked up a plan on what mitigation actions they intend to carry out they should contact our office to secure placeholders, this will give us time to work together with the appropriate point of contact for all projects, HMP development, and updates.

- BRIC Direct Technical Assistance (DTA) -

Overview:

- The BRIC program also offers help to communities and tribes in the form of *non-financial technical assistance* that can provide holistic hazard mitigation planning and project support.
- There is no requirement for a previous BRIC grant sub-application or award or an approved hazard mitigation plan to be eligible to apply.
- The application process bypasses partnering with DHS&EM, but communication is encouraged and welcomed.

Who is Eligible?

State Agencies, Boroughs, Cities, and Federally Recognized Tribal Governments with a FEMA
Approved and Locally Adopted Hazard Mitigation Plan as defined in 44 CFR Part 201. The entity
must have a FEMA approved HMP at the times of submittal and at grant award.

- Eligible Types of Projects -

- Capability & Capacity Building Initiatives
 - Project Scoping
 - Risk Analysis
 - Hazard Mitigation Planning
 - Managed Retreat Plans
 - Seismic Design Work
 - Projects that help design, scope, identify or reduce risks from natural hazards.

 - Building Codes and Standards Projects

- Structural Seismic Retrofits
- Structural Elevation and/or Relocation
- Property Acquisition & Demolition
- Soil Stabilization

- Critical Utility Hardening / Protection
- Wildfire / Combustible Fuels Reduction Projects
