## Significant Issues:

The SEOC Preparedness Level is at 2, to support wildland fires in the state. Numerous wildland fires in the Interior continued to spread over the weekend. More than 20,000 additional acres burned which resulted in evacuation and standby notices for several communities affecting both the Denali and North Star Boroughs.
The main Denali Borough area fires, five in total, have been combined into the Anderson Complex. The SEOC participated in the Great Basin's Type 2 Incident Management Team (IMT) In-briefing on Saturday and will continue to support the new team as they transition into full oversight on the Complex, effective immediately as well as any needs in the Fairbanks region.
