Significant Issues:

Clarks Point's Drinking Water Well:

An SEOC specialist will return today from Clarks Point. During the week the SEOC specialist met with local leadership, water treatment operator, Bristol Bay Area Health Corporation, multiple state agencies to include DEC and DCRA local government specialists to assist the community with identifying solutions for the current drinking water well. All involved parties also discussed long term plans for a new drinking water well.

SEOC specialist has also engaged the Alaska VOAD organization for mass care support and donation of water purification units.

The off-ramp from the southbound Glenn Hwy to the S. Old Glenn will be CLOSED nightly from 9PM to 5AM Sunday, July 14 through Thursday, July 18. To DETOUR around the closed off-ramp, keep heading south on the Glenn Hwy, exit at Eklutna, and use the on-ramp there to enter the Glenn Hwy headed north.
