Petersville Landslide:

ADEC advised SEOC of a landslide in Petersville. There were no immediate life-safety issues, but roadways may be compromised. SEOC is coordinating with the Matanuska-Susitna Borough and DOT.

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center is now at Preparedness Level **1**

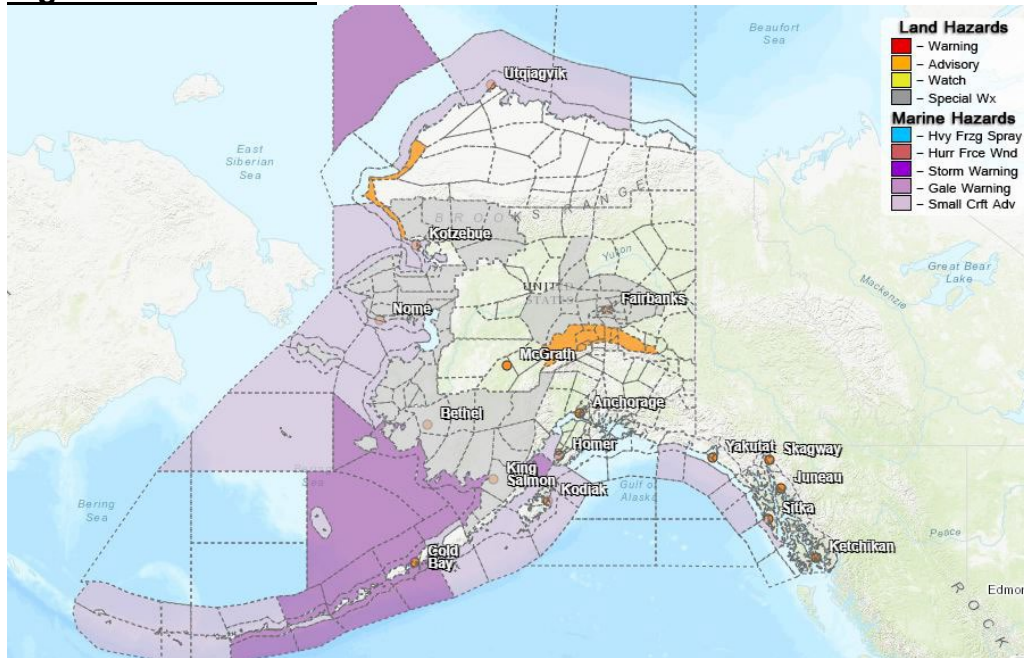

Wind Advisory:

- **Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp, Northern Denali Borough** – Starting 10am Thursday till 10am Friday

High Surf Advisory:

- **Western Arctic Coast; Kivalina and Red Dog Dock** – Till 10pm this Wednesday.

Special Weather Statement:

- **Northern Seward Peninsula; Shishmaref; Bering Strait Coast; Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Interior Seward Peninsula; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast; Lower Yukon River; St Lawrence Island** – A coastal storm is expected to impact the West Coast of Alaska Thursday and Friday.
- **Dalton Highway Summits; White Mountains and High Terrain South of the Yukon River; Upper Chena River Valley; Tanana Flats; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Chatanika River Valley; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area; Nenana; Central Interior** – Gusty winds Thursday and Friday
- **Lower Kuskokwim Valley; Kuskokwim Delta; Bristol Bay** - Active storm track to bring several rounds of heavy rain, winds, and possible coastal impacts to Southwest Alaska

Hydrologic Outlook:

- **South Slopes of the Western Brooks Range; Noatak Valley; Upper Kobuk Valleys, Bering Strait Coast; Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Interior Seward Peninsula** – Strong coastal storms expected Thursday through Sunday
