West Coast Storms:

The SEOC met in person with Calista Corporation, and Tribal leaders for the Yukon – Kuskokwim Regional Tribal Government yesterday to review storm damage reports from communities and connect appropriate assistance if needed.

Brevig Mission:

SEOC has been in contact with DOT regarding the recent periodic closure of the runway. DOT provided SEOC with trip report that stated the following.

- DOT investigation of the previously completed resurfacing project to determine causes for soft runway surface conditions was completed. Results were that due to rainfall and soft surface material, aircraft tires cause ruts to form, trapping water.
- DOT has since reported one runway has been opened to limited use while the primary runway continues to dry out.
- DOT/PF considering applying chipper and lime to stabilize the second runway within 24-48 hours.

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center is now at Preparedness Level **1**

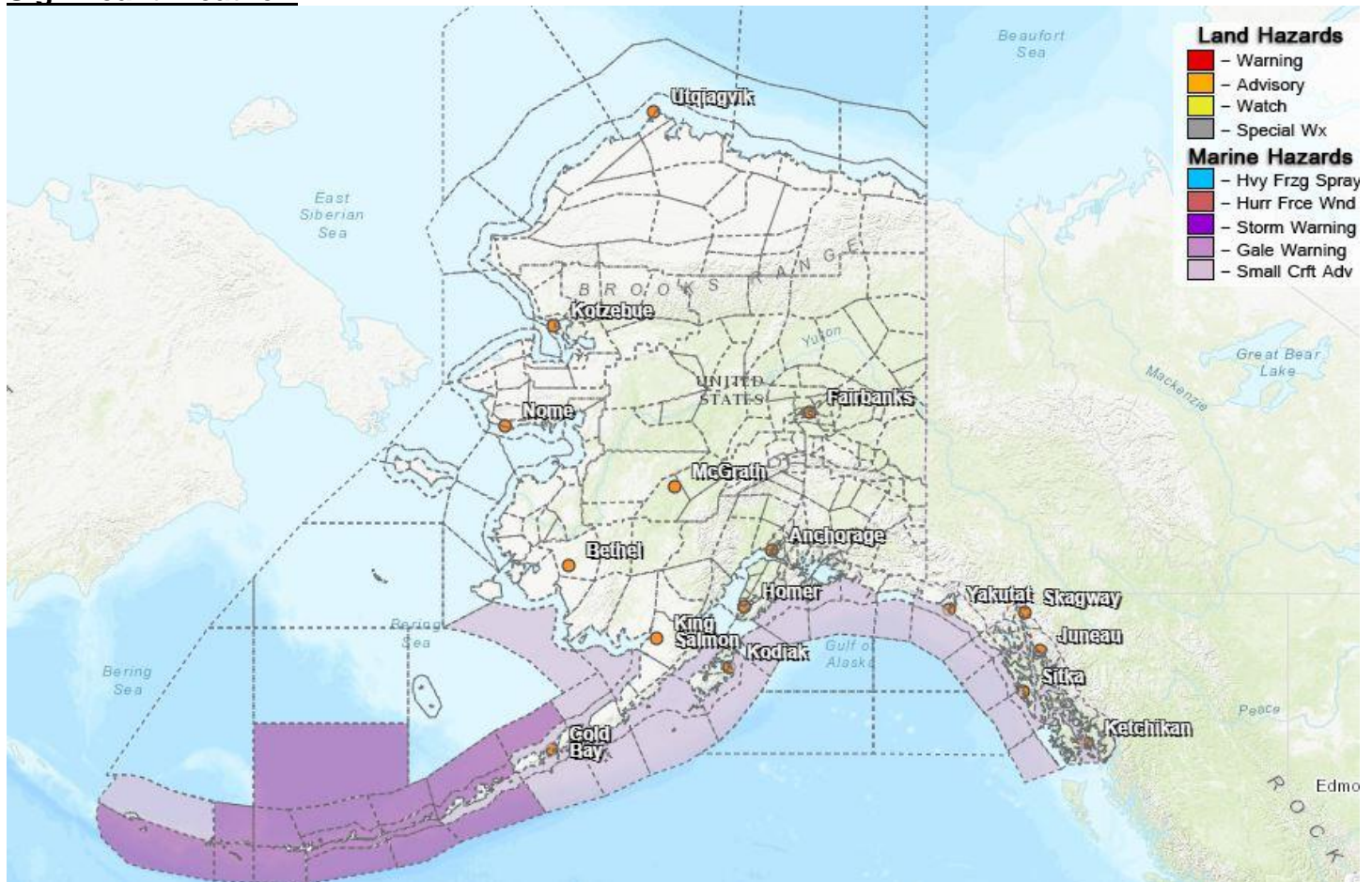
