Brevig Mission - The main runway 12-30 remains closed due to current conditions, but the forecast for the next several days predicts dry and windy weather, which will help dry out the runway. Maintenance and Operations staff from Nome are heading to Brevig Mission today to assist the RAM contractor in efforts to repair the main runway, and it is anticipated that the runway will soon be firm enough to reopen.

Currently, the secondary crosswind runway 5-23 has been operational since Sunday, which has allowed regular air service to Brevig Mission to resume. Pilots have reported that the crosswind runway is in good condition, and today's light rain has not affected its usability.
