Significant Issues:

Juneau Suicide Basin Update:

SEOC is closely monitoring the water levels in the Juneau Suicide Basin due to heavy rainfall during the last week of August. SEOC has been in contact with NWS, CBJ Assistant Manager to discuss concerns over refilling of the Mendenhall Glacier Dam Lake and the potential for additional flooding.

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center is now at Preparedness Level 1

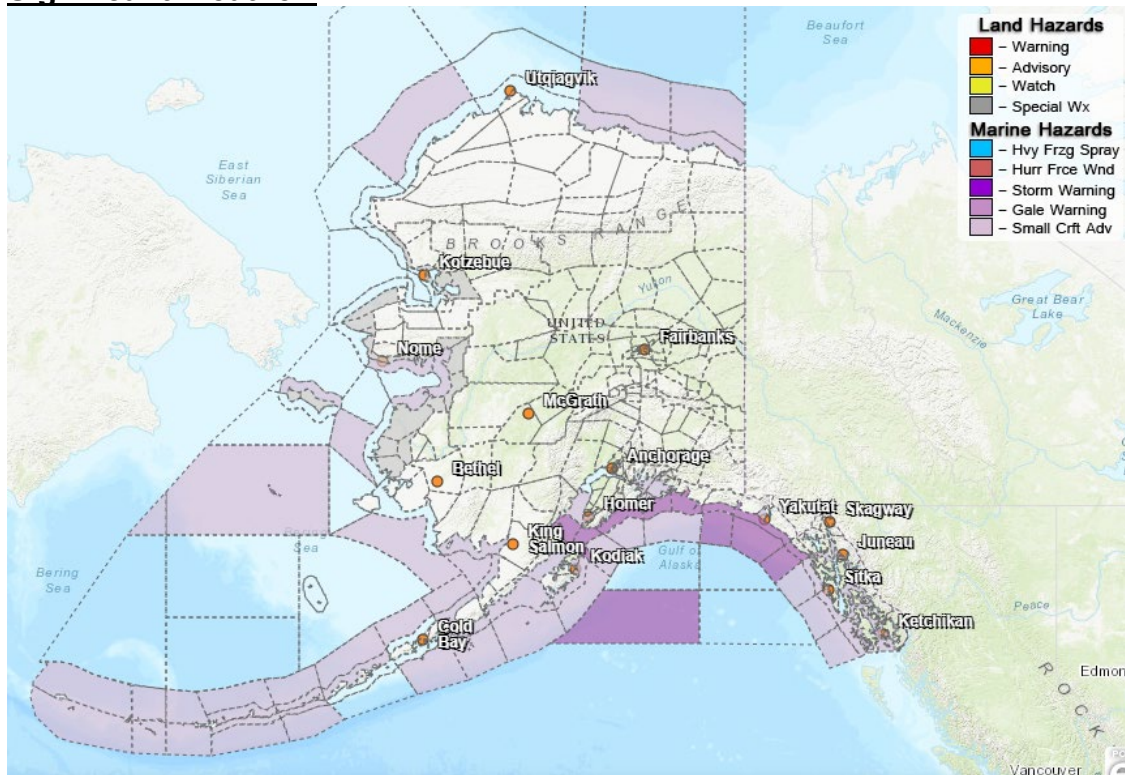
