**Significant Issues:**

**Juneau Suicide Basin Update:**

SEOC is closely monitoring the water levels in the Juneau Suicide Basin due to heavy rainfall during the last week of August. SEOC has been in contact with NWS, CBJ Assistant Manager to discuss concerns over refilling of the Mendenhall Glacier Dam Lake and the potential for additional flooding. **NWS will provide a weather briefing for SEOC Friday morning.**

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center is now at Preparedness Level 1

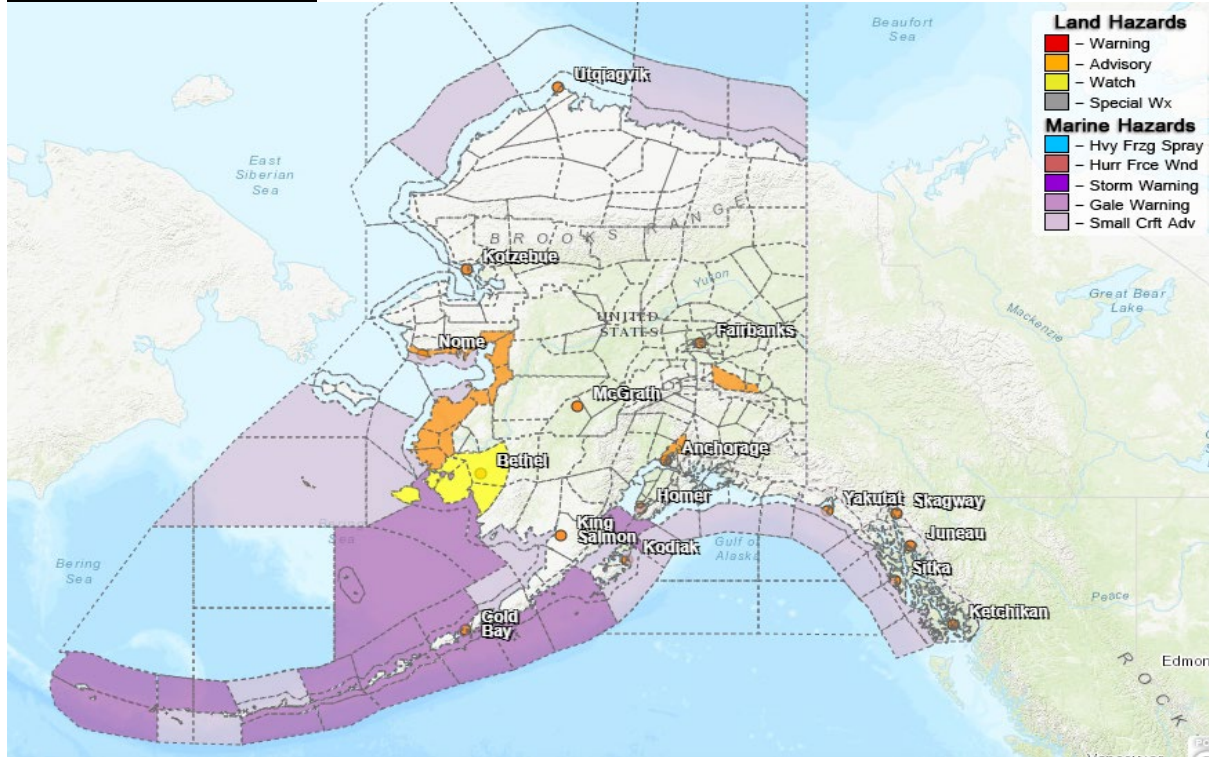

### Flood Watch:

**Kuskokwim Delta**-in effect from Saturday through Sunday afternoon along Kuskokwim River from Bethel to mouth of river.

### Coastal Flood Watch:

**Kuskokwim Delta**- Saturday morning through late Sunday night along coast from the mouth of Kuskowim river to Newtok.

### Coastal Flood Advisory:

**Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills**-noon Saturday until 10am Monday.

### High Surf Advisory:

**Southern Seward Peninsula Coast**- noon Saturday until midnight Sunday.

**Yukon Delta Coast**-6am Saturday until 6am Monday.

### Wind Advisory:

**Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp**-in effect from 4pm Saturday to 1pm Sunday.
