Significant Issues:

Aleutian Islands & Bristol Bay Storm:

Yesterday afternoon, the SEOC was notified by the National Weather Service about High Wind Warnings along the Western, Central and Eastern Aleutian Islands. Winds are projected to reach 40-55mph with gusts up to 75mph.

Out of an abundance of caution, SEOC staff contacted communities across the Aleutians and Bristol Bay regions to relay the storm information, encourage preparedness actions and remind communities to contact SEOC if assistance is needed.

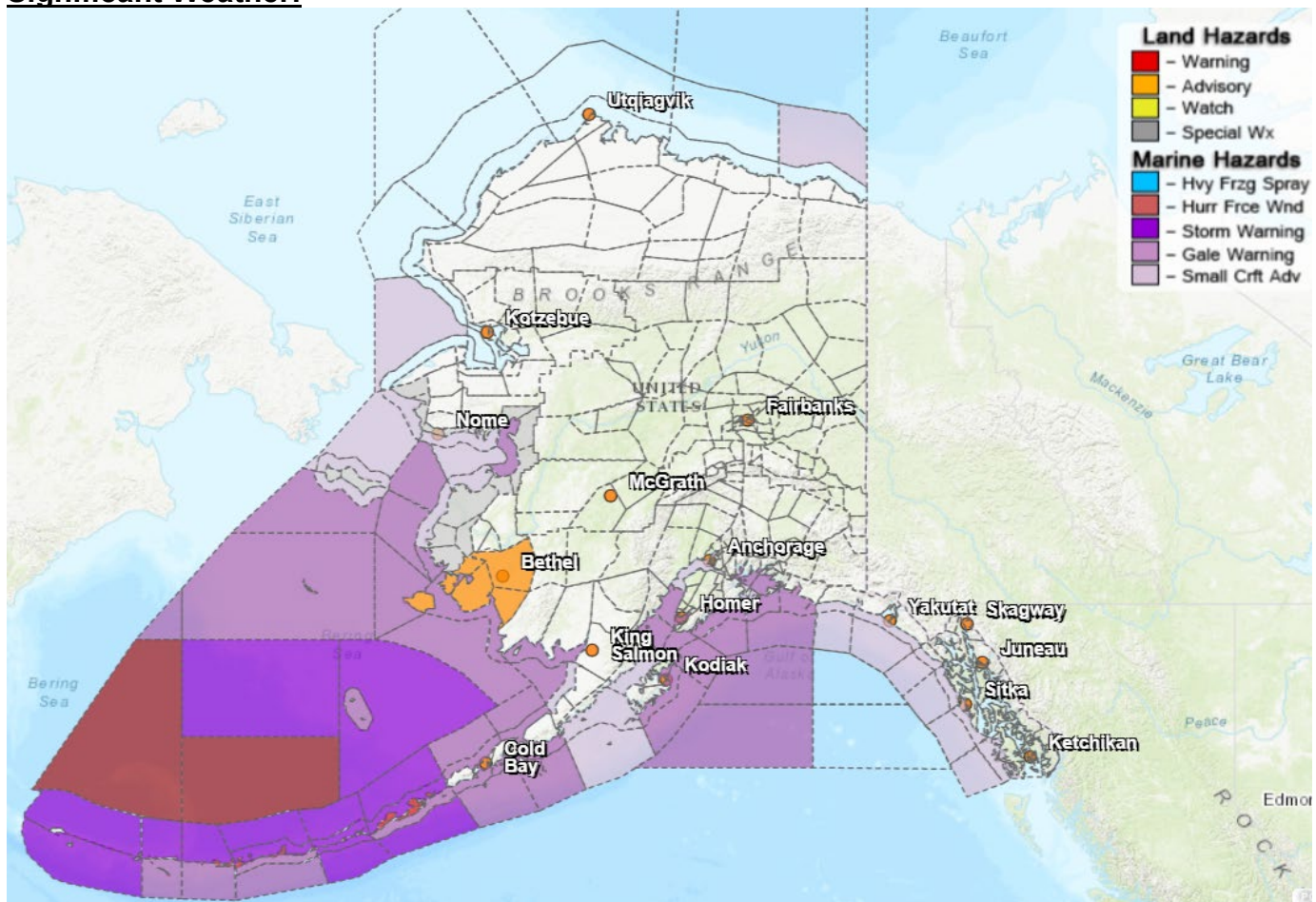

High Wind Warning:

- **Central Aleutians**- remains in effect until 1am Friday.
- **Eastern Aleutians**-remains in effect from 4pm this afternoon until 8pm Friday.

Special Weather Statement:

- **Bering Strait Coast, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Yukon Delta Coast, St Lawrence Island**-gusty winds expected today through Friday.
- **Pribilof Islands**- strong winds and high seas from this morning through late Friday evening.

High Surf Advisory:

- **Kuskokwim Delta**-in effect from this morning until 7am Friday.
