Significant Issues:

Landslide Response – Ketchikan

The Fire Chief in Ketchikan informed the State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) of a landslide blocking the roadway on North Tongass Highway. Four of the eight individuals on the other side of the slide have safely self-extricated—the remaining four plan to drive to a nearby harbor for boat pick-up. A Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT/PF) geohazard assessment team, equipped with drones, is en route to evaluate the situation. Ketchikan Maintenance and Operations (M&O) is prepared to clear the road once it is safe. SEOC will remain engaged in support as needed.

Hurricane Helene and Milton Support

SEOC Operations is engaged in supporting states impacted by Hurricane Helene and incoming Hurricane Milton. We are actively monitoring EMAC requests nationwide and will deploy as available. We currently have four staff deployed to Virginia, North Carolina, and Florida.

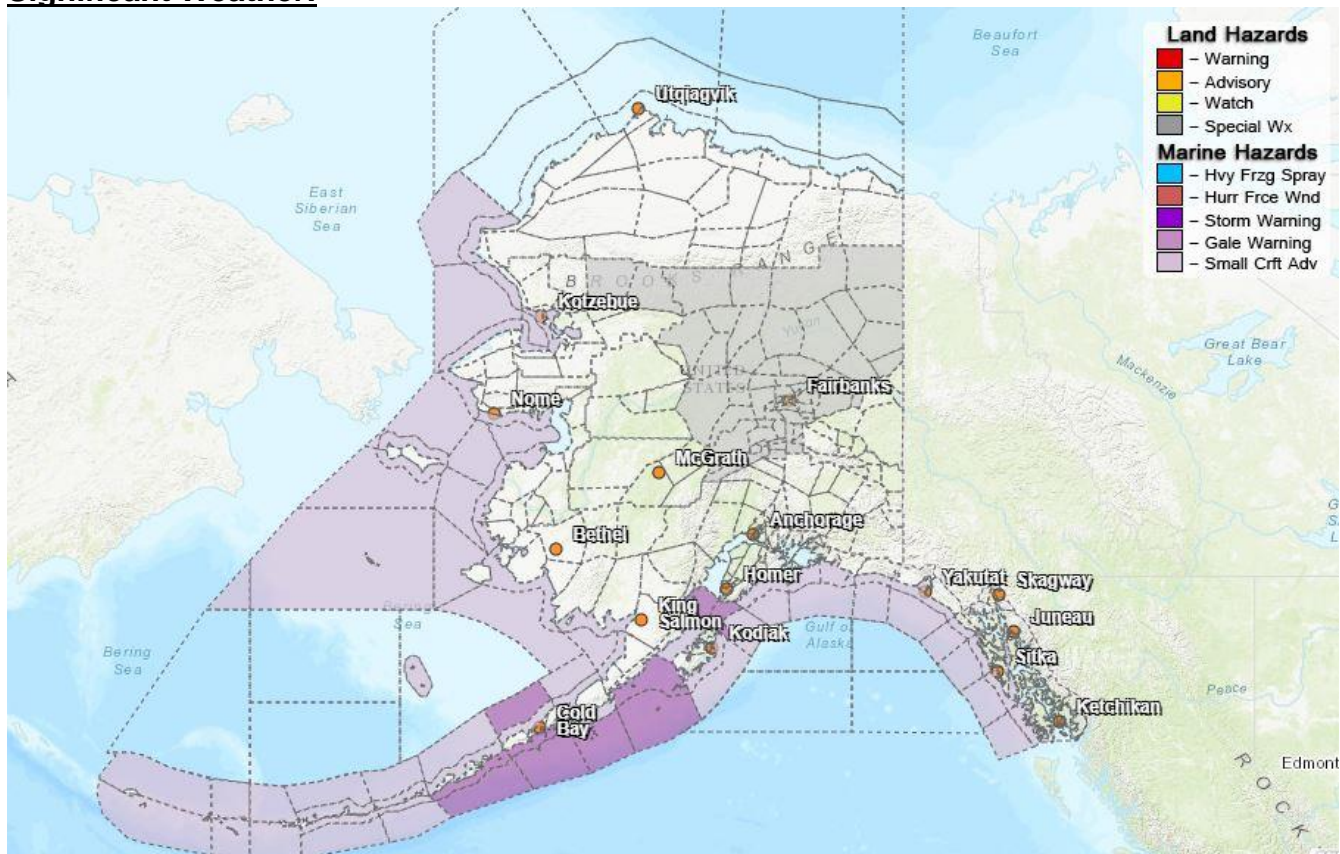
