National Hurricane Support:

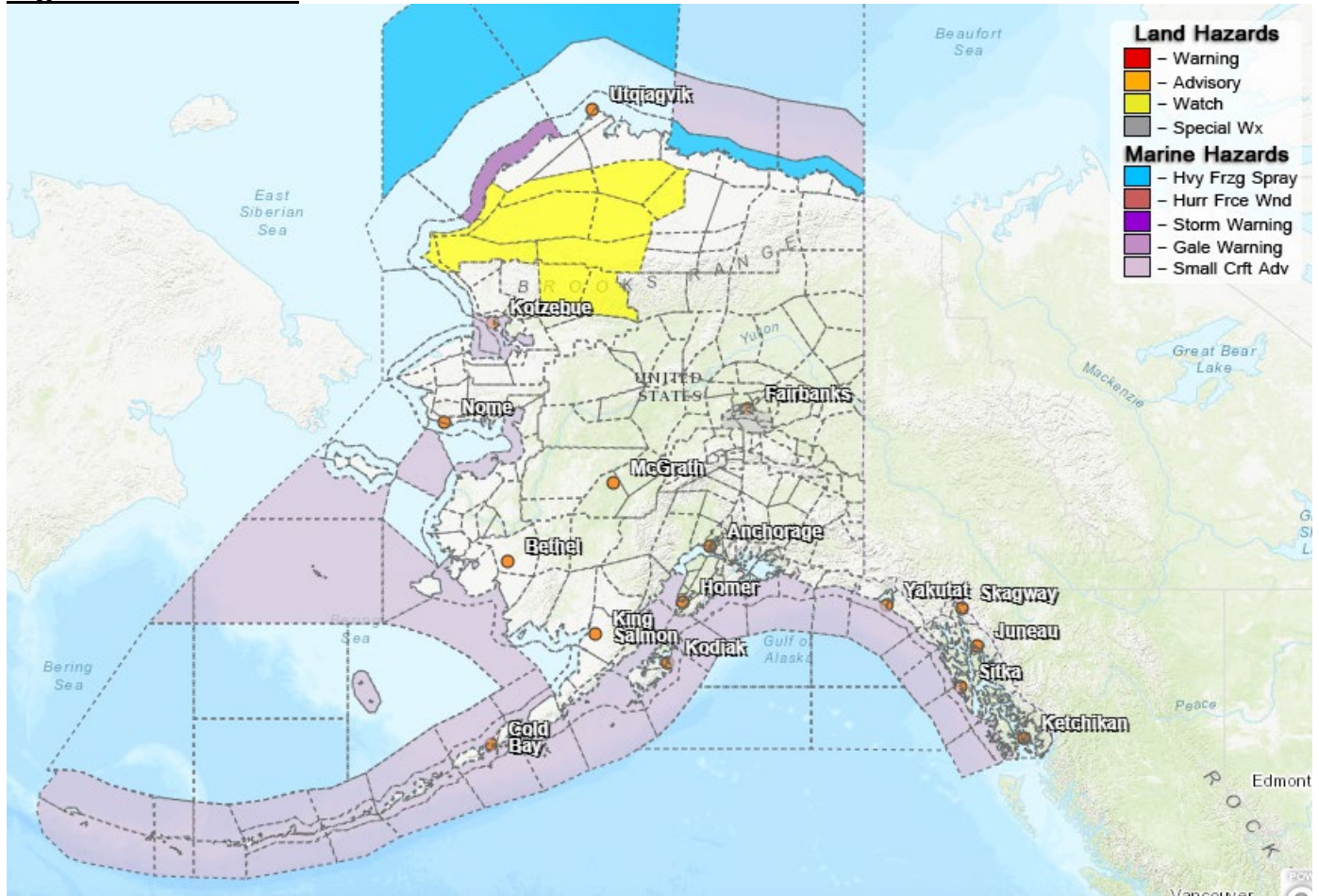
