National Hurricane Support:

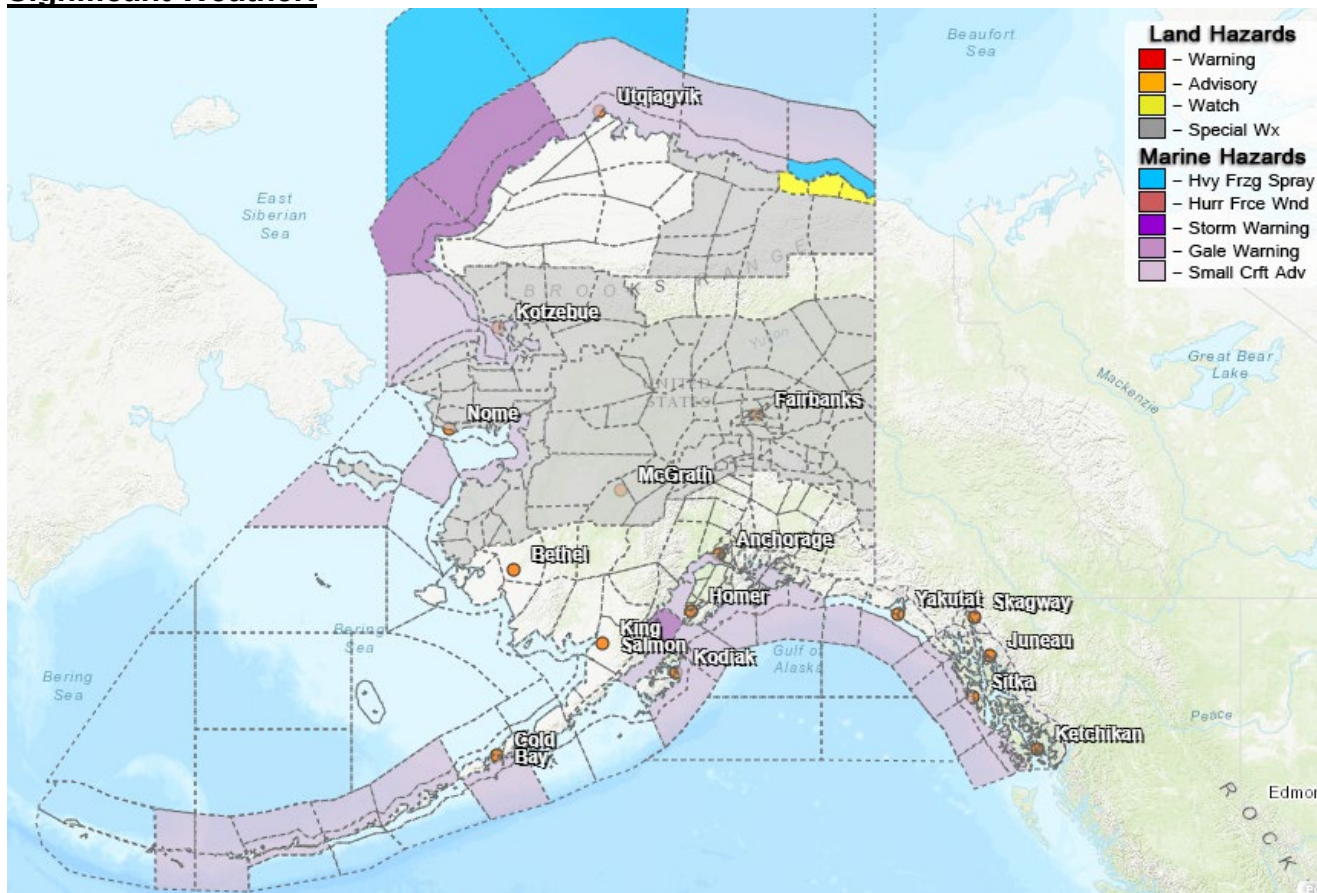

Special Weather Statement:

- **Central Beaufort Sea Coast, Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast, Central Arctic Plains, Central Brooks Range, Romanzof Mountains**-Snow and blowing snow today into Thursday.
- **Upper Koyukuk Valley, Dalton Highway Summits, Yukon Flats, White Mountains and High Terrain South of the Yukon River, Forty-Mile Country, Upper Tanana Valley, Delta Junction, Upper Chena River Valley, Tanana Flats, Eielson AFB and Salcha, Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills, Chatanika River Valley, Two Rivers, Fairbanks Metro Area, Nenana, Central Interior, Northern Denali Borough, Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp**- coldest temperatures of the season Friday through Sunday, followed by potential winter storm Sunday night through Tuesday.
- **South Slopes of the Western Brooks Range, Noatak Valley, Kivalina and Red Dog Dock, Lower Kobuk Valley, Baldwin Peninsula, Northern Seward Peninsula, Upper Kobuk Valleys, Shishmaref, Bering Strait Coast, Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, Interior Seward Peninsula, Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills, Yukon Delta Coast, Lower Yukon River, St Lawrence Island, Lower Koyukuk Valley, Middle Yukon Valley, Lower Yukon and Innoko Valleys, North Slopes of the Western Alaska Range, Upper Kuskokwim Valley**-Bering Sea storm Sunday through early Wednesday.
