### Significant Issues:

## **West Coast Storm:**

#### **SEOC** Response in Kotzebue:

- State Disaster Individual Assistance registration opened yesterday for Kotzebue.
- SEOC DIVSUP and Mass Care Group Supervisor arrived in Kotzebue last night.
- Division of Forestry crew of 9 will arrive today to assist with de-watering and residential cleanup.
- AKOM has 1 State Active-Duty officer in Kotzebue currently and 8 additional service members will arrive in the next 24 hrs.
- Current Residential Damage Assessment-10 residential structures with significant damage, 1
  residential structure with minor damage. Damage Assessment are on-going.
- Infrastructure damage of Sewage Lagoon is being determined.
- Red Cross arrived yesterday and will be conducting residential damage assessments over the weekend and begin immediate assistance delivery.
- AEA has power restored to National Weather Service Building. Transmission line is working, and generators are on standby.
- Kotzebue Airport is fully functionable, though de-watering mitigation will continue throughout the day.
- ANTHC Logistic Chief will arrive today to support Kotzebue City and NWAB Incident Commands.

#### Other Storm Communities:

SEOC continues to receive damage reports from other communities in the impact area, but currently there are no reports of damages requiring immediate state response support.
