Significant Issues:

West Coast Storm:

SEOC continues at Level 2, engaged in a full multiagency response to Kotzebue, Northwest Arctic Borough (NWAB) and other communities impacted by the 2024 October West Coast Storm disaster. SEOC Kotzebue Field Division Supervisor (DIVSUP), Kotzebue Borough DIVSUP, and Kotzebue Mass Care Group Supervisor are in Kotzebue coordinating the state response with NWAB and City of Kotzebue Incident Commands and implementing Governor Dunleavy's declaration of disaster.

Kotzebue:

- Anchorage churches Change Point and Mountain City deployed a disaster response repair team to Kotzebue to assist with home construction repair. They coordinated yesterday with the National Guard Task Force Kotzebue leadership and Kotzebue DIVSUP to address immediate resident repair needs for winter safety.
- SEOC has ordered a mutual aid Volunteer Agency Liaison from Colorado through the Emergency Management Assistance Compact to assist in Kotzebue's long-term recovery planning. She will arrive Friday.
- SEOC approved additional disaster supplies (plywood and insulation) to provide for emergency winter repairs to residences.
- 2 families with disability needs and elders are being addressed by the Kotzebue Mass Care Group Supervisor.
- Kotzebue DIVSUP traveled to Deering today with the NWAB Mayor to assess damages there.

- State Disaster Individual Assistance registration is open for residents in Kotzebue. Multiple inperson, door-to-door registrations were taken, and an in-person meeting location is open again at the NWAB office with state and NWAB representatives.
- Division of Forestry and Fire Protection (DOF&FP) crew continued work de-watering properties with pumps and hoses and assisting with disaster cleanup. Orders extended through Friday with de-mob planned Saturday.
- A team of Alaska Organized Militia (AKOM), composed of Alaska National Guard and Alaksa State
 Defense Force service members continues working on the following:
 - Distributing relief supplies including heaters, dehumidifiers, and emergency repair materials
 - Assisting residents with home damage to sewer, water, and gas lines
 - Repairing wheelchair access and stairs
 - Stabilizing fuel tanks
 - Clearing storm debris from properties
 - Assisting with drying out subflooring
- Village Public Safety Officers are working alongside DOF&FP and AKOM teams to assist residents.


