Significant Issues:

West Coast Storm:

SEOC continues to support transition to recovery efforts in Kotzebue, Northwest Arctic Borough (NWAB) and other communities impacted by the 2024 October West Coast Storm disaster.

- State Disaster Individual Assistance registration is open for residents in Kotzebue. As of today, the State has received **57** IA applications.
- De-mob last Friday and Saturday for Division of Forestry and Fire Protection (DOF&FP) Crew and the team of Alaska Organized Militia (AKOM), composed of Alaska National Guard and Alaska State Defense Force Service Members
- SEOC Borough DIVSUP de-mobilized on Friday night.
- SEOC deployed a Volunteer Agency Liaison yesterday who is mutual aid from Colorado under the Emergency management Assistance Compact, to Kotzebue, to support long-term recovery efforts.
- Operations transitioning to NWAB Arctic Borough as responders demobilize.

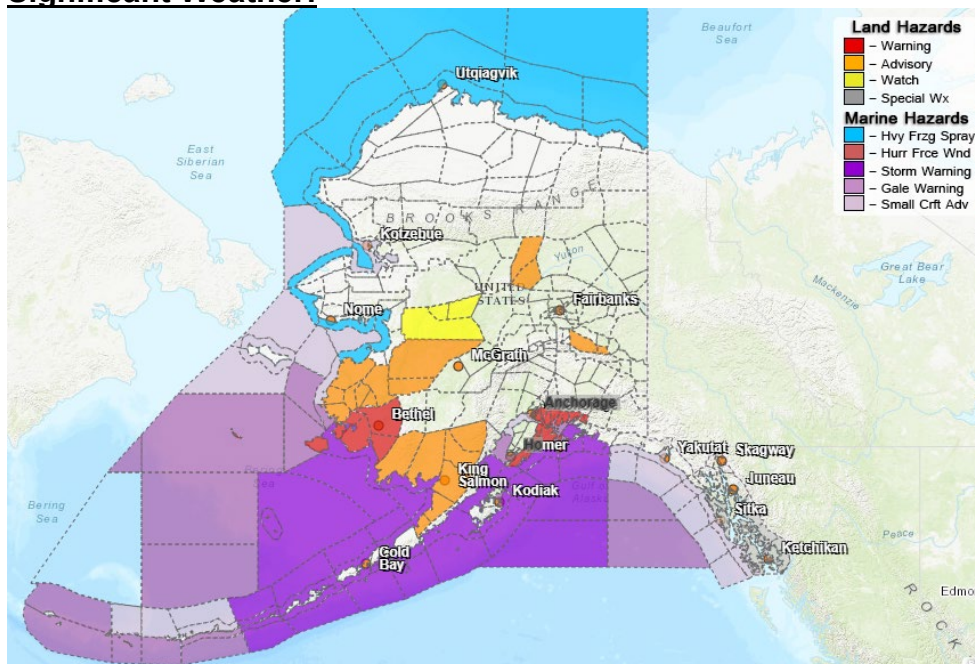
