Significant Issues:

West Coast Storm:

SEOC continues to support transition to recovery efforts in Kotzebue, Northwest Arctic Borough (NWAB) and other communities impacted by the 2024 October West Coast Storm disaster.

- State Disaster Individual Assistance registration is open. As of today, the State has received **60** IA applications.
- SEOC deployed a Volunteer Agency Liaison yesterday who is mutual aid from Colorado under the Emergency management Assistance Compact, to Kotzebue, to support long-term recovery efforts.

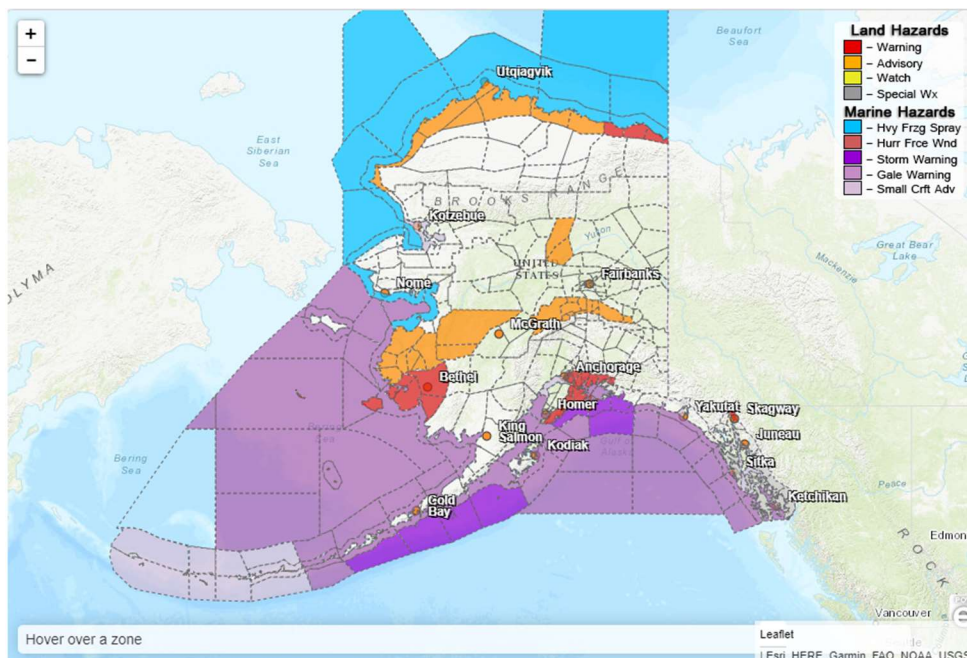

Special Weather Statement:

- **City and Borough of Sitka, Petersburg Borough, Western Kupreanof and Kuiu Island, Prince of Wales Island, City and Borough of Wrangell, Ketchikan Gateway Borough, City of Hyder, Annette Island**-heavy rain today through early Friday.

Blizzard Warning:

- **Northeast Prince William Sound-** in effect until 6pm for Thompson Pass.
- **Kuskokwim Delta-** in effect until 1pm this afternoon.
- **Pribilof Islands-** in effect until 10am this morning.

Winter Storm Warning:

- **Western Prince William Sound-** in effect until 4pm this afternoon for Turnagain Pass & Summit Lake.
- **Municipality of Skagway** – in effect until 9PM AKDT tonight.
- **Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast** – in effect from Noon today until Midnight AKST Wednesday night.

Winter Weather Advisory:

- **Dalton Highway Summits** – in effect until Midnight AKST tonight.
