## **Significant Issues:**

#### West Coast Storm:

SEOC continues to support transition to recovery efforts in Kotzebue, Northwest Arctic Borough (NWAB) and other communities impacted by the 2024 October West Coast Storm disaster.

- State Disaster Individual Assistance registration is open. As of today, the State has received 60
  IA applications.
- SEOC deployed a Volunteer Agency Liaison yesterday who is mutual aid from Colorado under the Emergency management Assistance Compact, to Kotzebue, to support long-term recovery efforts.



#### **Blizzard Warning:**

- Northeast Prince William Sound- in effect until 6pm for Thompson Pass.
- Kuskokwim Delta- in effect until 1pm this afternoon.
- Pribilof Islands- in effect until 10am this morning.

#### Winter Storm Warning:

- Western Prince William Sound- in effect until 4pm this afternoon for Turnagain Pass & Summit Lake.
- Municipality of Skagway in effect until 9PM AKDT tonight.
