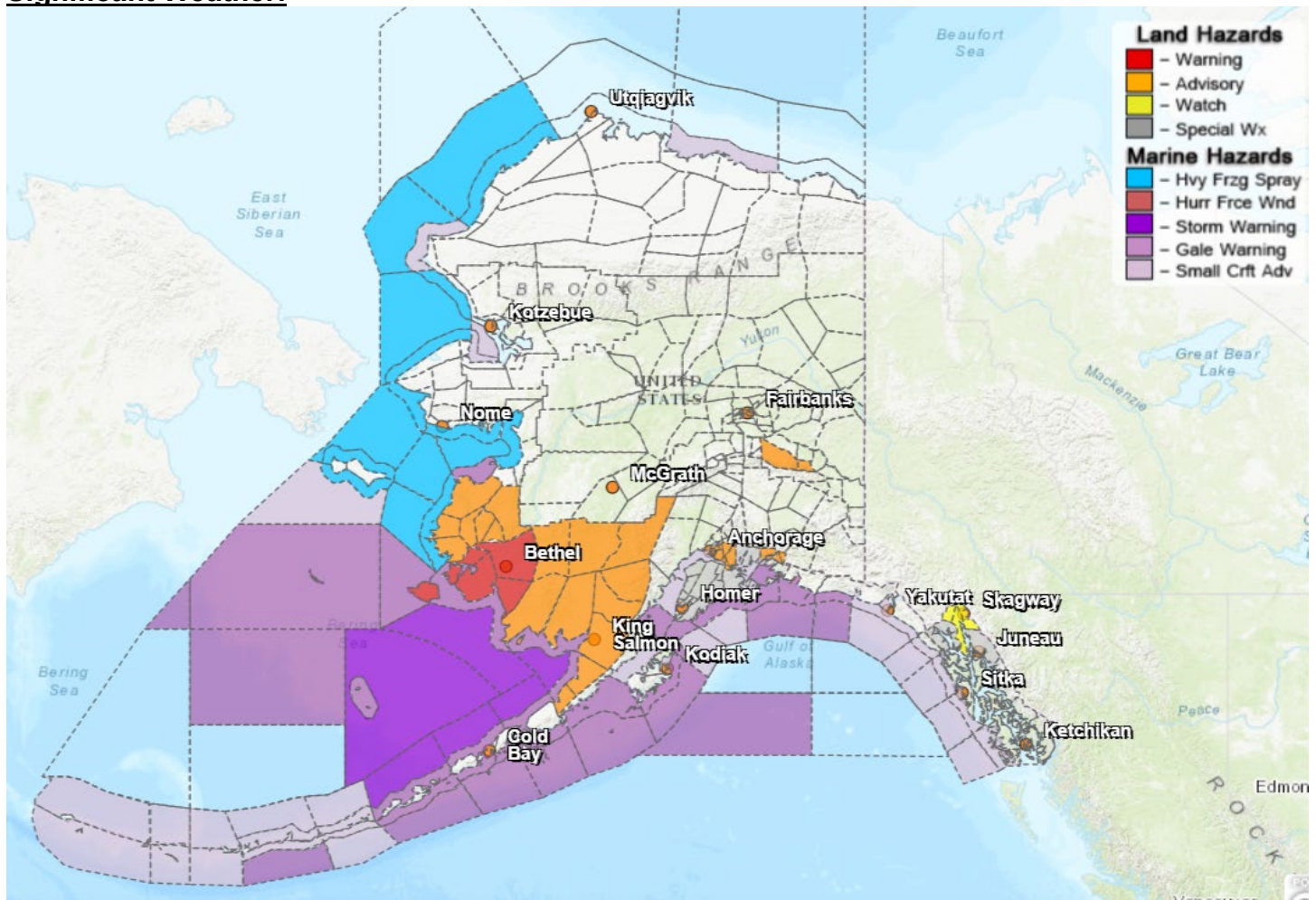

Special Weather Statement:

- **Western Kenai Peninsula**-areas of snow and blowing snow along the Sterling Hwy corridor from Anchor Point north to Nikiski, Thursday afternoon through Friday evening.
- **Western Prince William Sound**-snow and blowing snow for Turnagain Pass and Whittier Thursday afternoon through Friday morning.
- **Bristol Bay**-gusty winds, blowing snow, and snow transitioning to rain expected through Friday evening.
- **Glacier Bay, City and Borough of Juneau**-potential for snow Thursday night into Friday morning.

Blizzard Warning:

- **Kuskokwim Delta**-from midnight tonight until 4am Friday for the Kuskowim Delta north and west of the river including Nunivak.

High Surf:

- **Bristol Bay**-from 1pm Thursday to 1am Friday

Wind Advisory:

- **Eastern Alaska Range of Trims Camp**-from 6pm this evening until noon Friday.

Dense Fog Advisory:

- **Anchorage**-in effect until 11am this morning.

Winter Weather Advisory:

- **East Turnagain Arm**-in effect from 3pm this afternoon to 3 am Friday for Portage Valley.
- **Northeast Prince William Sound**-from 8pm this evening to 8am Friday for Thompson Pass.
- **Lower Yukon, Yukon Delta Coast**-from 6am Thursday until 6am Friday.
- **Lower Kuskokwim Valley**-in effect from 10am Thursday to 4am Friday.

Winter Storm Watch:

- **Municipality of Skagway Borough**-late tonight through Friday evening.
