

- **Western Kenai Peninsula-**areas of snow and blowing snow along the Sterling Hwy corridor from Anchor Point north to Nikiski, Thursday afternoon through Friday evening.
- **Western Prince William Sound-**snow and blowing snow for Turnagain Pass and Whittier Thursday afternoon through Friday morning.
- **Bristol Bay-**gusty winds, blowing snow, and snow transitioning to rain expected through Friday evening.
- Glacier Bay, City and Borough of Juneau-potential for snow Thursday night into Friday morning.
