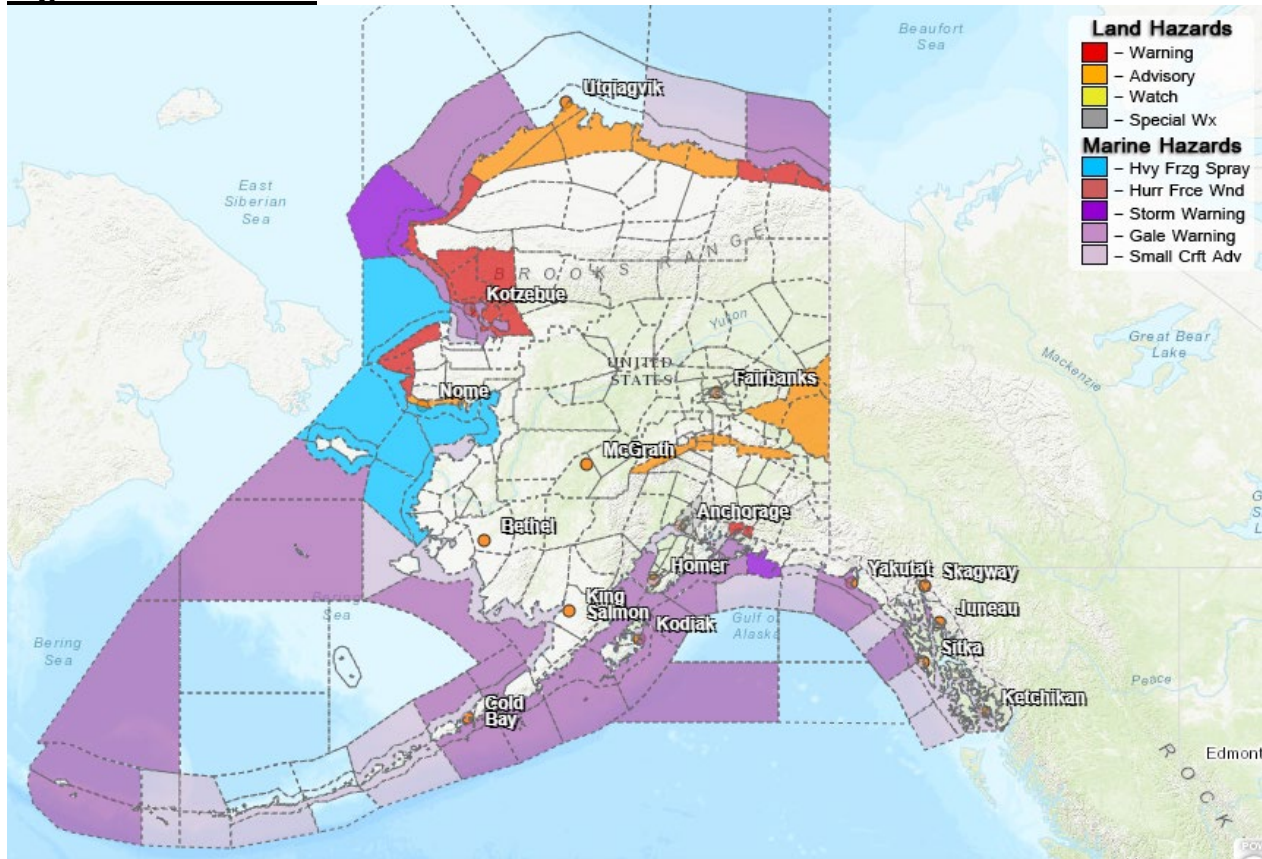

- **Anchorage, Matanuska Valley**– strong winds and areas of blowing snow this afternoon through early Tuesday.

### Air Quality Alert:

- **Fairbanks Metro Area**-in effect until noon today.

### Winter Weather Advisory:

- **Southern Seward Peninsula Coast**-in effect from midnight tonight to 3pm Wednesday.
