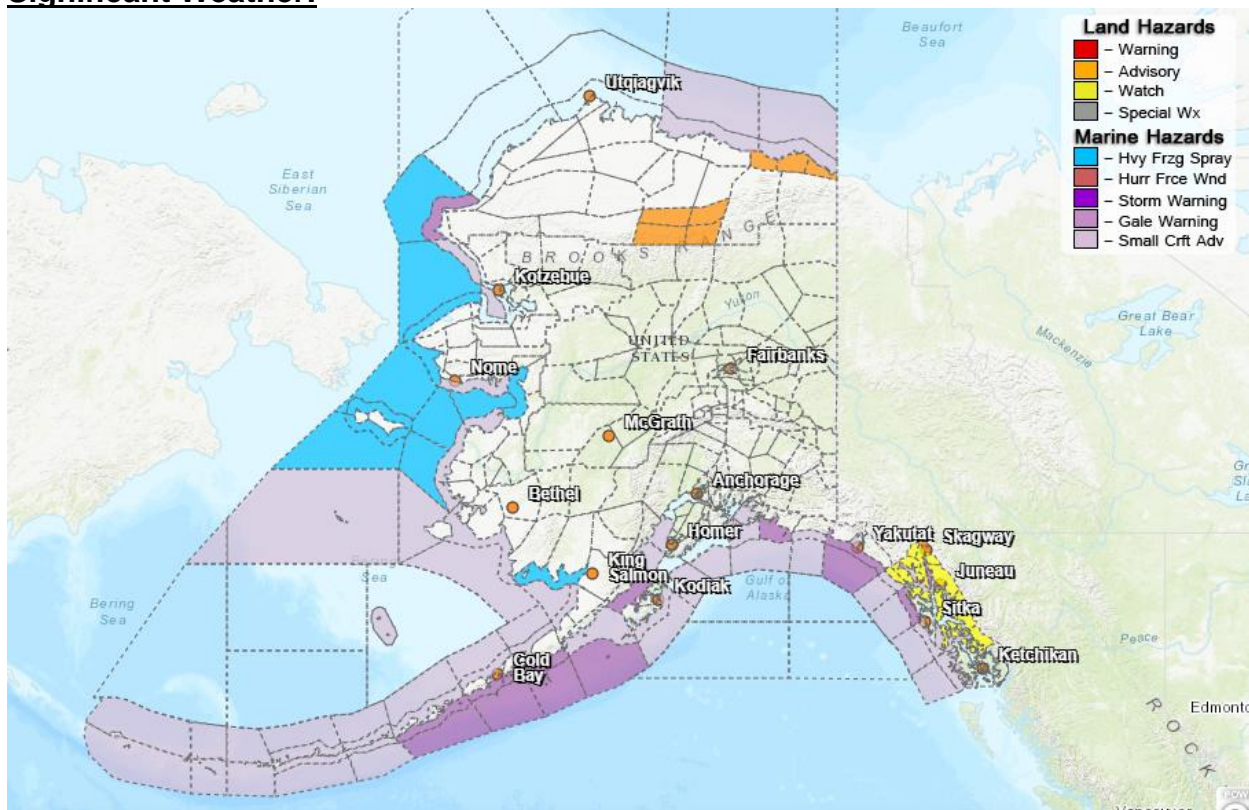

Significant Weather:



Winter storm watch:

- City of Hyder for Saturday afternoon through Sunday night for heavy snow accumulation of 10-13 inches.
- Admiralty Island, Petersburg Borough, Western Kupreanof Island, Kuiu Island and the City and Borough of Wrangell from Saturday afternoon through Sunday night for snow accumulation of 2-4 inches.
- Municipality of Skagway from Saturday afternoon through Monday morning for snow accumulation of 8-11 inches and winds gusting to 40mph.

Winter weather advisory in effect for the Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast and the Central Brooks Range from 6pm Friday until 6pm Saturday for snow accumulation of 2 inches and winds gusting to 35mph causing blowing snow conditions.

Cold weather advisory issued for the municipality of Skagway starting at 9pm Friday until 9am Saturday.
