Significant Issues:

2024 October West Coast Storm:

A joint Preliminary Damage Assessment team combined with State, FEMA, and SBA began the damage assessments in Kotzebue and expects to be completed today.

Russian Mission Water Outage:

A RMW (Remote Maintenance Worker) deployed to the community to assist in repairs. As of last night, the pump has been repaired and water is circulating in all loops. The supply line is still frozen and assessments to service lines are pending. ADEC (Alaska Department of Conservation) has issued a boil water notice. The tribe received bottled water from YKHC which were distributed to community members.

Ketchikan Landslide:

SEOC attended a city EOC call with the National Weather Service and State Geologist. The community has experienced small landslides with no impacts but have concerns about a potential landslide occurring that could trigger damages to structures and cause flooding. State Geologist is deploying to the community today to assess the slope and assist in mitigation efforts.

Kiana Frozen Water Line:

Northwest Arctic Borough (NWAB) reported that Kiana was experiencing a frozen water supply line leaving the community without running water. Maniilaq deployed a RMW who arrived in the community yesterday. Water was transferred to the tank using a fire hose and thawing the line is in progress. A boil water notice was also issued for the community as well.

Kwigillinok Power Outage:

SEOC received a report that the community was out of power and awaiting parts. AEA was notified and determined that the community was utilizing a smaller generator for power while repairs to the

bigger generator were pending, with the school and teacher housing using a standby generator to partially power the water and sewer lines. New generators for the community are being procured but won't be available until early next year.

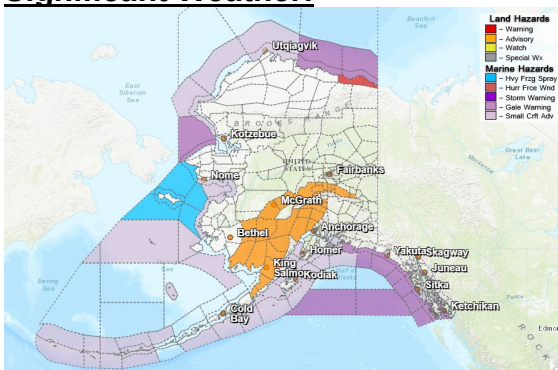

- **Susitna Valley** – Remains in effect until 3am Thursday.

Blizzard Warning:
