### **Significant Issues:**

#### **City of Hooper Bay:**

SEOC was notified of a power outage affecting the community's water pump and water availability. A Boil Water Notice was placed in effect until enough water can be pumped to clear the lines and fill the tank. The community expects to have potable water by end of day Friday. **The city declared a local disaster yesterday afternoon.**

#### **Adak Power Issue:**

SEOC received word Tuesday from Adak's City Manager that power was out to the entire community of Adak. **SEOC spoke with TDX who reported that they are aware of power disturbances that are due to an outdated distribution system. A lineman and subcontractors will deploy to the community on Saturday to diagnose the fault in the power system. 95% of the community has had their power restored.**

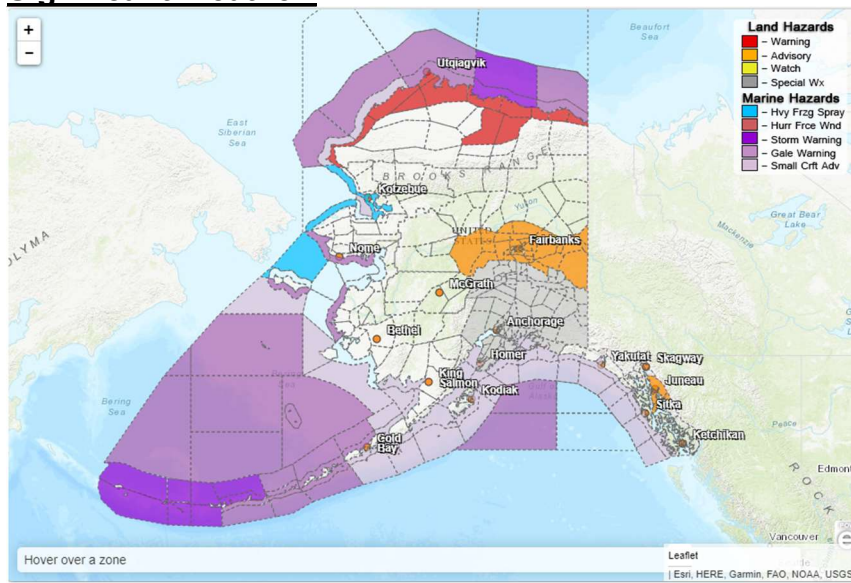

## **Dense Fog Advisory:**

- **Admiralty Island; City and Borough of Juneau** – in effect until Noon today.

## **Flood Advisory:**

- **Western Kenai Peninsula** – in effect until 1:15PM this afternoon.

### **Special Weather Statement:**

- **Delta Junction; Upper Chena River Valley; Tanana Flats; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area; Nenana; Central Interior** – heavy snow ongoing or expected.
- **Upper Tanana Valley; Northern Denali Borough; Southern Denali Borough; Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp; Eastern Alaska Range South of Trims Camp** – significant snow likely today and Friday.

### **Winter Weather Advisory:**

- **Fortymile Country; Delta Junction; Upper Chena River Valley; Tanana Flats; Eielson AFB and Salcha; Goldstream Valley and Nenana Hills; Chatanika River Valley; Two Rivers; Fairbanks Metro Area; Nenana; Central Interior; White Mountains and High Terrain South of the Yukon River** – in effect until 9PM Friday night.

### **Blizzard Warning:**

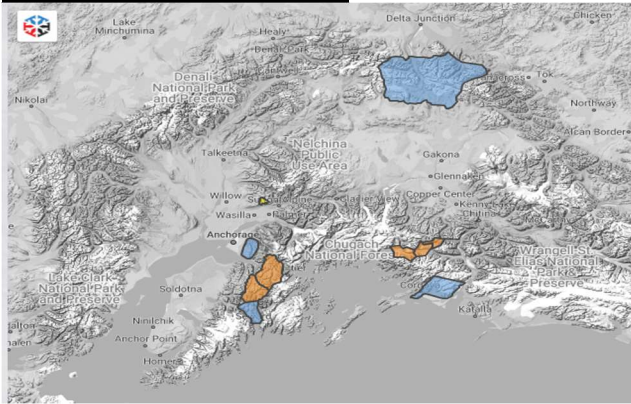
- **Western Arctic Coast, Northwest Arctic Coast, Northern Arctic Coast; Central Arctic Plains, Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast, Central Beaufort Sea Coast**- remains in effect until 3pm on Friday.

### **Hydrologic Outlook:**

- **Anchorage, East Turnagain Arm, Matanuska Valley, Western Kenai Peninsula, Western Prince William Sound, Northeast Prince William Sound, Southeast Prince William Sound, Copper River Basin, Susitna Valley** - ice action on area rivers could produce some jam flooding due to recent warm temperatures.

### **Avalanche Conditions:**



- **Turnagain Pass** – Moderate 1,000-2,500', Considerable above 2,500'.
- **Summit Lake** – Moderate 1,000-2,500', Considerable above 2,500'
- **Hatcher Pass** – Moderate above 3,500'.
- **Maritime** – Moderate from 1,500-3,000', Considerable above 3,000'.
- **Intermountain** – Considerable above 4,000', Moderate below.
- **Valdez** – Considerable above 4,000', Moderate below.
