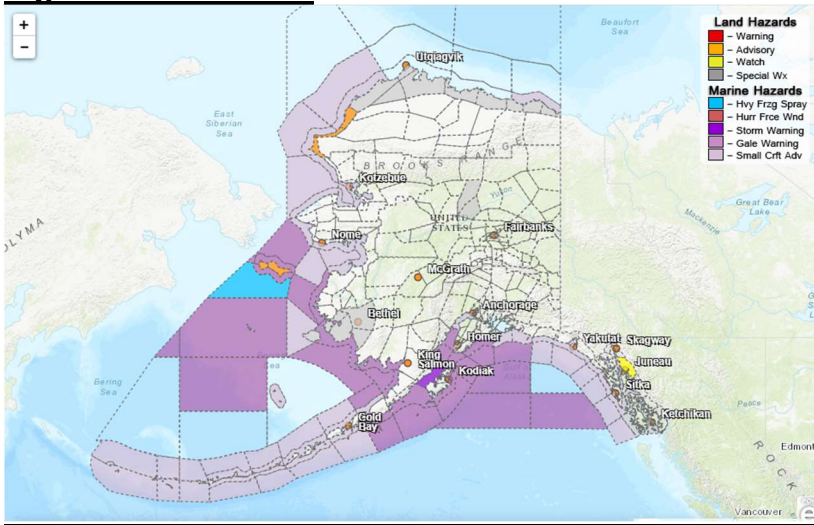

Dense Fog Advisory:

- **Ketchikan Gateway Borough** - in effect until 11AM this morning.

High Wind Watch:

- **City and Borough of Juneau** - in effect from late tonight through Wednesday morning.

Special Weather Statement:

- **Northwest Arctic Coast; Northern Arctic Coast; Central Beaufort Sea Coast; Eastern Beaufort Sea Coast** – Cold Wind Chills and Blowing Snow Potential through Wednesday.
- **Kuskokwim Delta** – Potential for Blowing Snow and Elevated Water Levels along the Kuskokwim Delta Coast through tonight.
- **Dalton Highway Summits** – Blowing Snow and Cold Wind Chills until Tuesday morning.

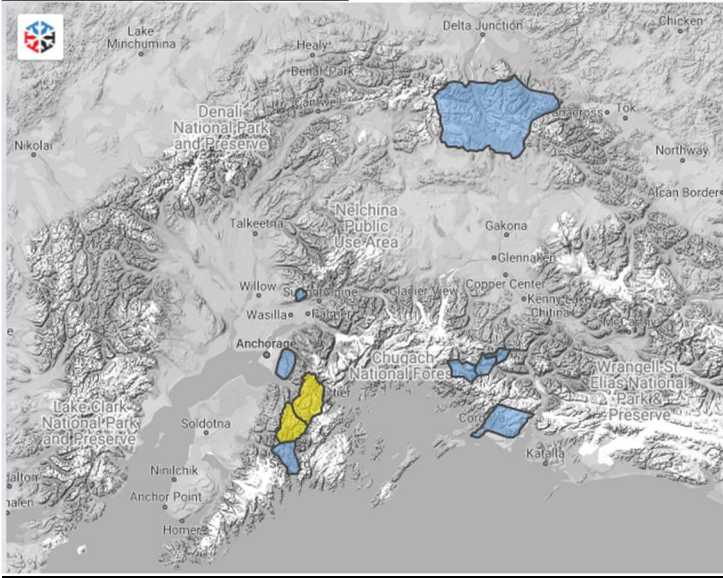
Winter Weather Advisory:
