**Significant Issues:**

**Akiak Power Disruptions:**

City of Akiak was able to conduct emergency repairs to one generator on Sunday and restore power to the community. Further repairs will need to be made to remaining generators to ensure consistent power to Akiak. SEOC remains engaged with the community and all available agencies to find solutions to stabilize and repair this community.

**2024 Spring Flood Disaster:**

**Kuskokwim Division:**

Governor Dunleavy has declared a disaster for the Kuskokwim River communities in the Lower Kuskokwim and Yupiit Regional Education Attendance Areas in response to flooding. The disaster recovery Individual Assistance program, that provides grant funding to individuals and families with damaged to primary residence or essential personal property lost during the flooding, is now open for those in the declared area.

SEOC is actively assisting Kwethluk as they fully restore their community water system.
