Significant Issues:

Unalakleet Power Disruption –

SEOC was notified yesterday regarding power disruptions in Unalakleet, community reported they were without power Tuesday night for 8 hours. Power was partially restored early Wednesday morning by the Unalakleet Valley Electric Cooperative (UVEC) repair team. UVEC has a repair plan in place and projects full power restoration by early this weekend.

SEOC also contacted the City of Unalakleet to identify any unmet needs. None were mentioned but there would be a concern for the community water plant that is currently running on backup power to reduce the community wide electrical usage, if normal power is unstable for an extended period.

SEOC will continue to monitor the situation and engage with partner agencies to support the current response efforts.

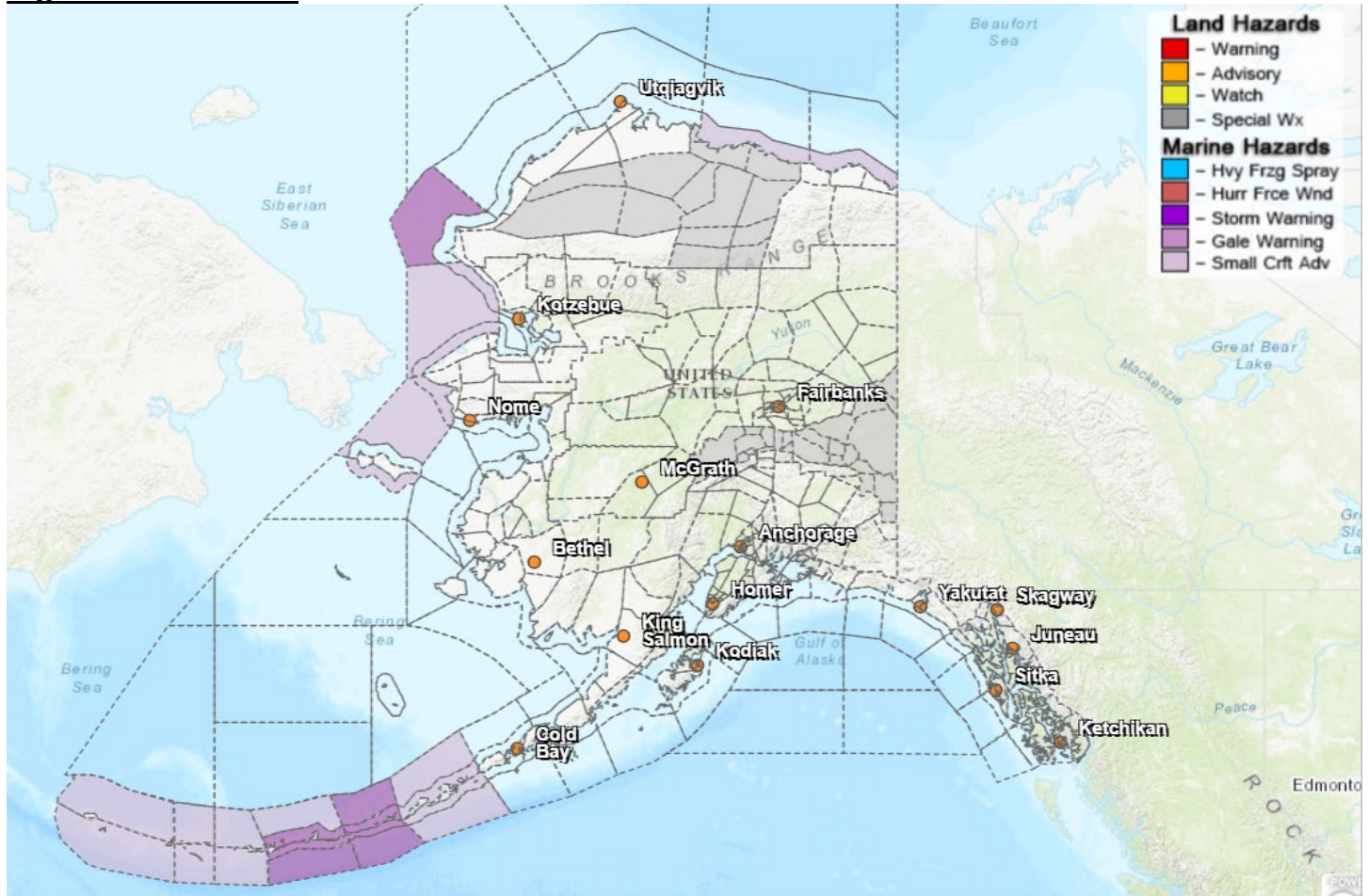
