Alaska Wildland 2024 Fire Season:

The Alaska Interagency Coordination Center upgraded the Preparedness <u>Level to 2</u> in affect starting at noon on June 17. This is due to the hot, dry weather combined with recent and expected lightning. The levels range from 1 (minimal activity) to 5 (very high activity). See links below (page 2) for more information.
