Alaska Wildland 2024 Fire Season:

As of Sunday, June 23rd, the Alaska Interagency Coordination Center upgraded the **Preparedness Level to 3.** This is due to increased levels of initial and extended attack, as well as anticipated warm and dry weather. The levels range from 1 (minimal activity) to 5 (very high activity). See links below (page 2) for more information.
