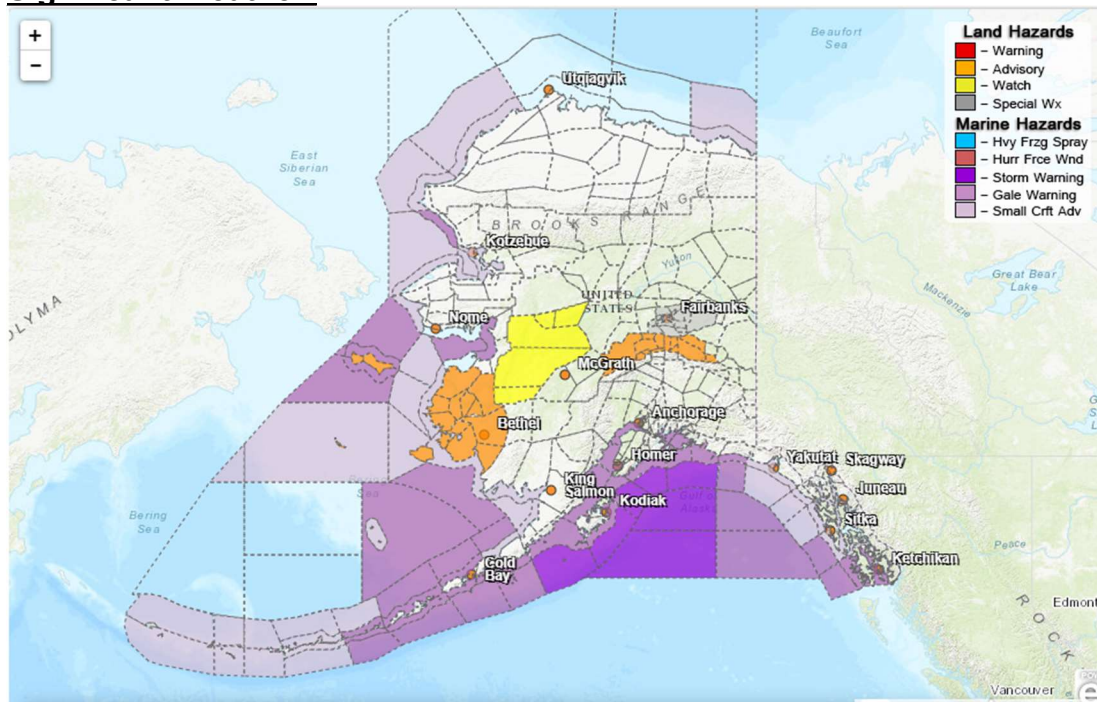

Northern Denali Borough, Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp-in effect from 3am Saturday thru late Sunday night.

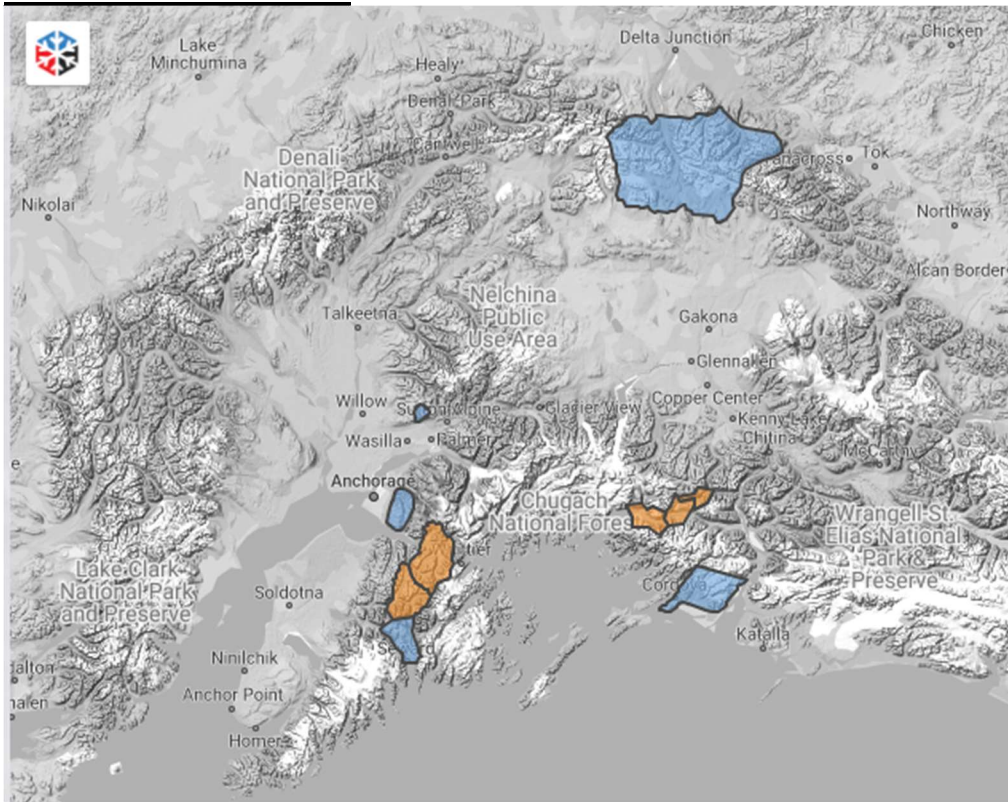
Coastal Flood Advisory:
