Selawik Disaster Declaration:

Governor Dunlevy declared a disaster for the City of Selawik late yesterday afternoon. The Northwest Arctic Borough Emergency Management Team responded to Selawik yesterday to confirm reports of frozen water lines and other infrastructure damage due to an inoperable boiler. SEOC will continue to assist the NWAB, and City of Selawik.

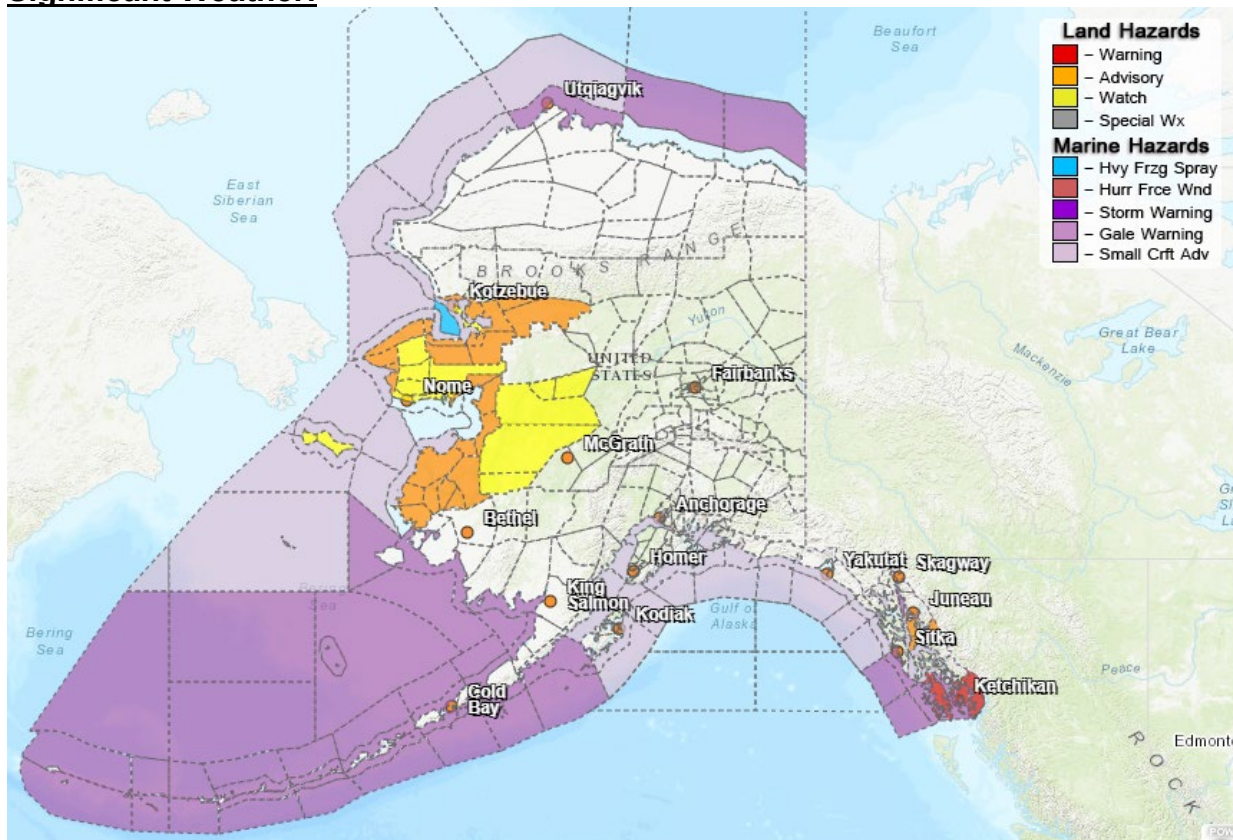

Baldwin Peninsula-from late Thursday night through Friday afternoon.

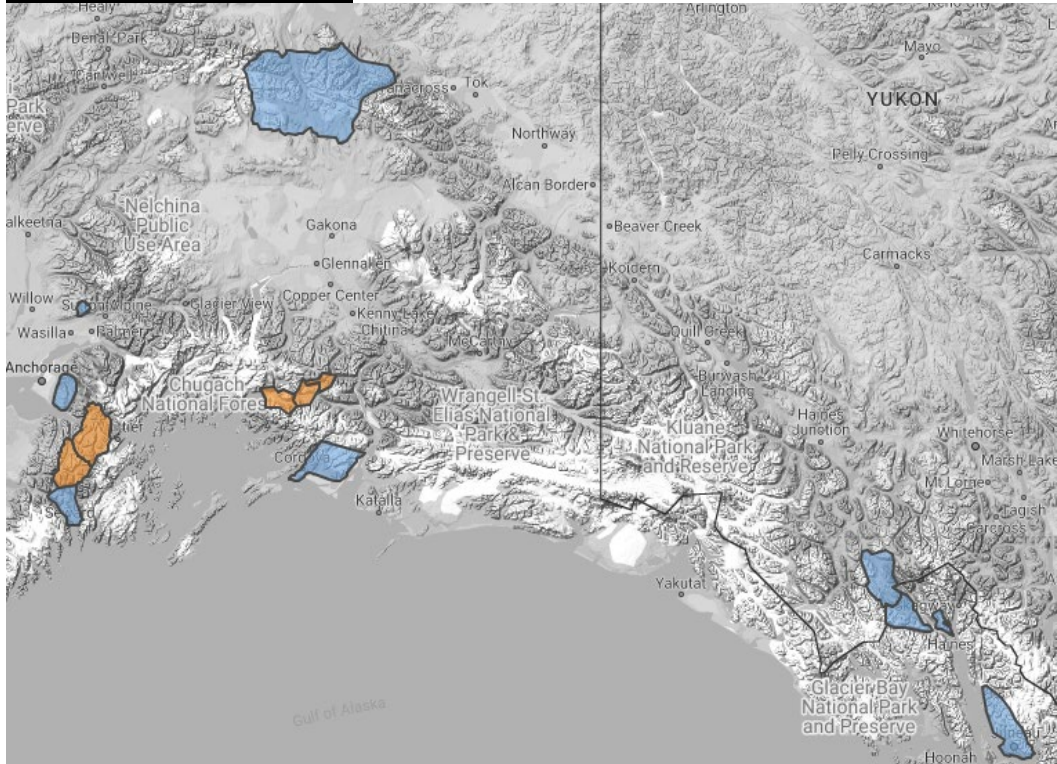
Southern Seward Peninsula Coast, Interior Seward Peninsula-late Thursday night through Saturday afternoon.
