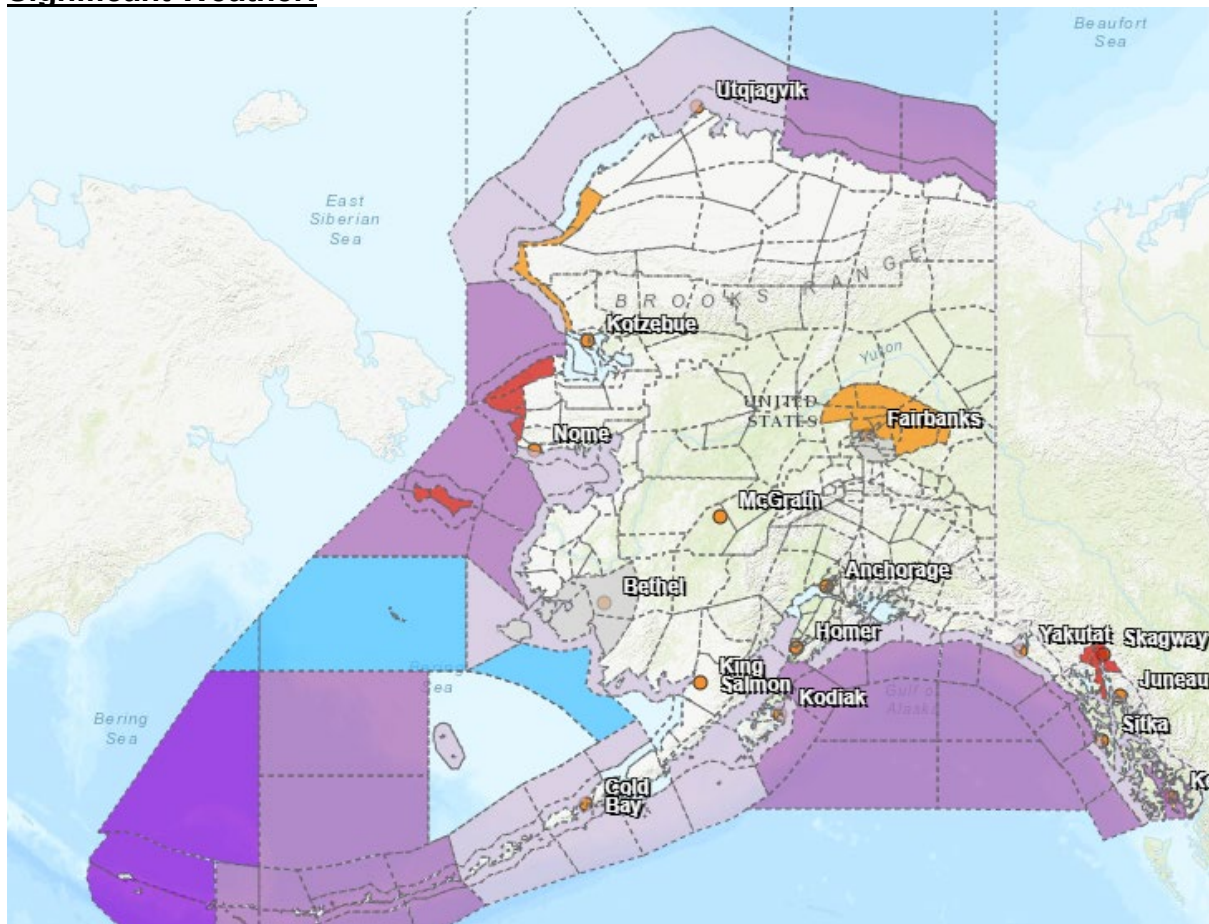

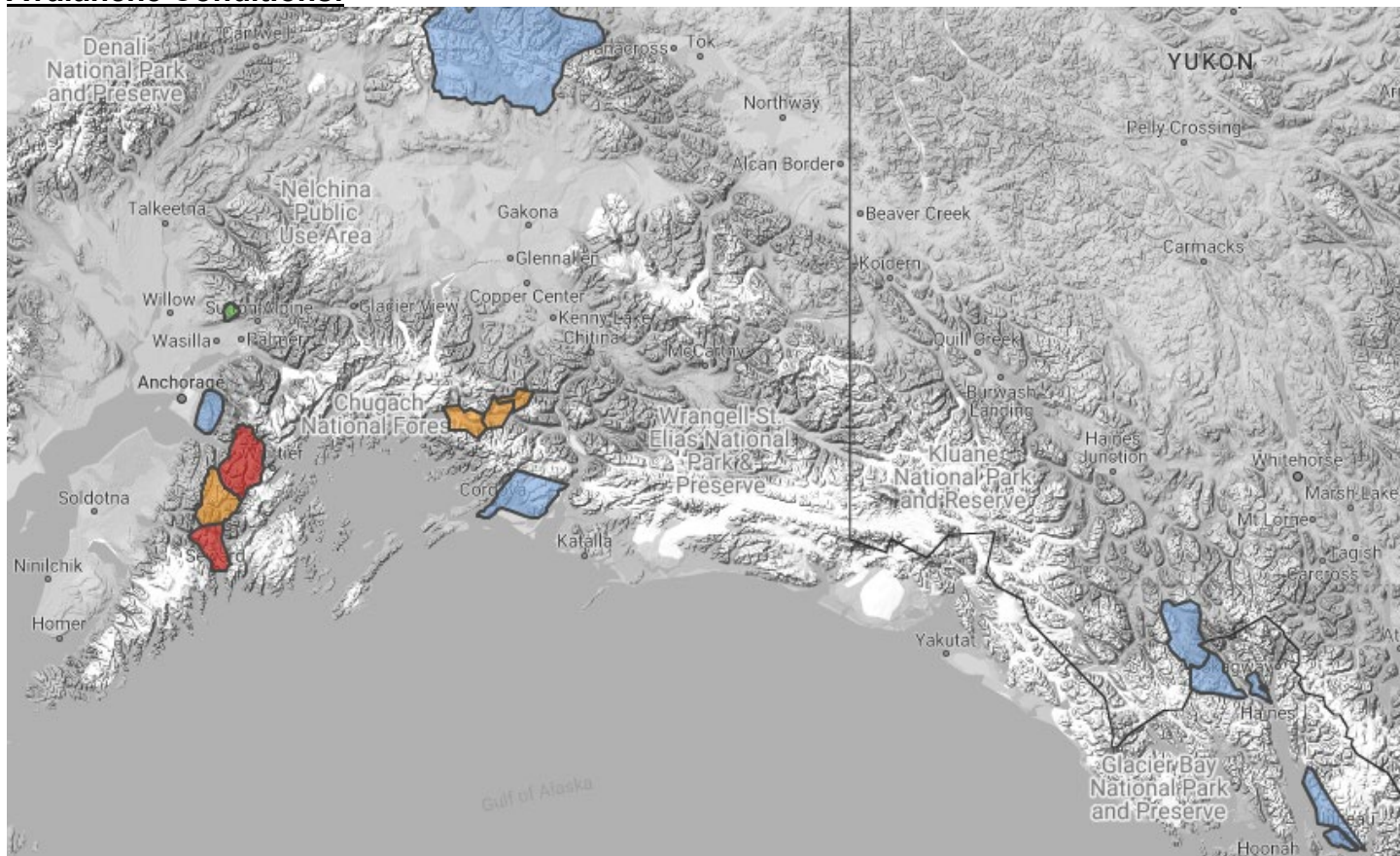

Turnagain Pass – Considerable below 1,000', High above 1,000'

Summit Lake – Low Below 1'000, Moderate 1,000' to 2,500, Considerable above 2'500

Seward and Lost Lake – Considerable below 1,000 to 2,500', High above 1,000'

Valdez Maritime- Moderate below 1'500, Considerable above 1,500

Intermountain – Moderate below 2'000, Considerable above 2,000

Continental – Moderate below 2'000, Considerable above 2,000'

Hatcher Pass –Low at all levels.
