Significant Issues:

Ketchikan Landslide: City and Borough of Ketchikan have declared a disaster. The community experienced a landslide yesterday that closed the main highway. No report of injuries. Two SEOC Specialists are enroute, will arrive by afternoon. SEOC is participating in daily meetings with Ketchikan's EOC and is ready to offer additional support.

Earthquake Swarm, Adak: SEOC is tracking the swarm of earthquakes that hit near Adak this morning. Community and Earthquake Center reports no damages. Earthquake center will issue a summary and updates later today. SEOC will continue to monitor situation.


