**Significant Issues:**

**2025 Riverwatch Operations**

SEOC will deploy to the Kuskokwim Division on Wednesday April 30<sup>th</sup>, the Upper Yukon Division on Thursday May 1<sup>st</sup>, and the Middle Yukon Division on Wednesday May 7<sup>th</sup>, to commence the annual Riverwatch aerial surveillance of ice and river conditions during spring break-up.

The Divisions, staffed with SEOC Operators and National Weather Service (NWS) Hydrologists, will fly rivers as breakup proceeds providing local communities with real-time reports on river conditions and flood risk. Divisions will be immediately available should flooding occur to support local response.

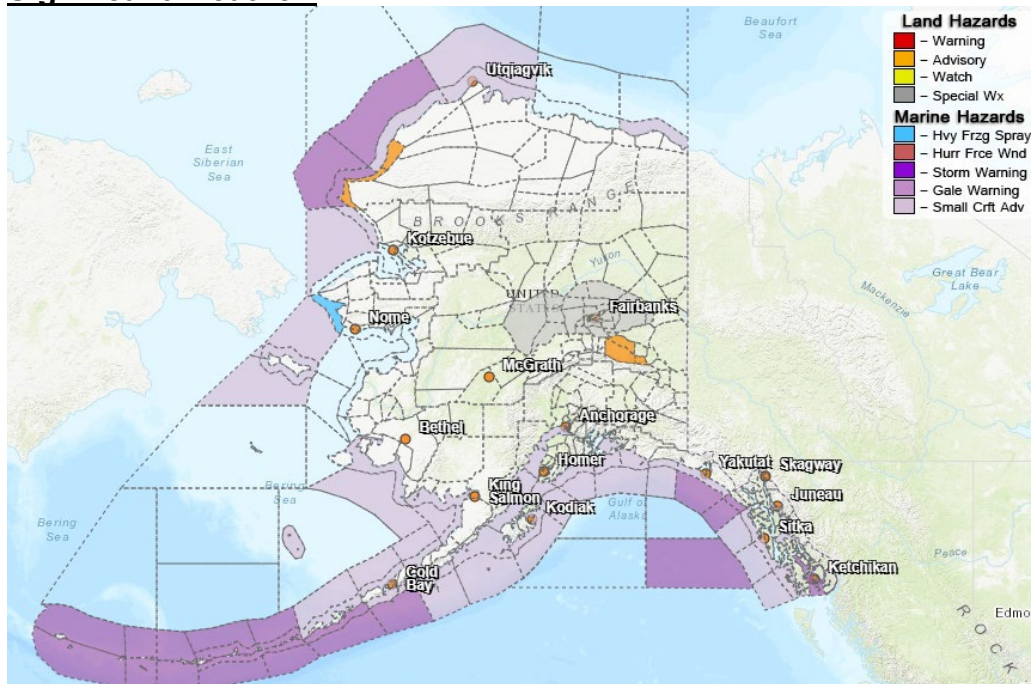

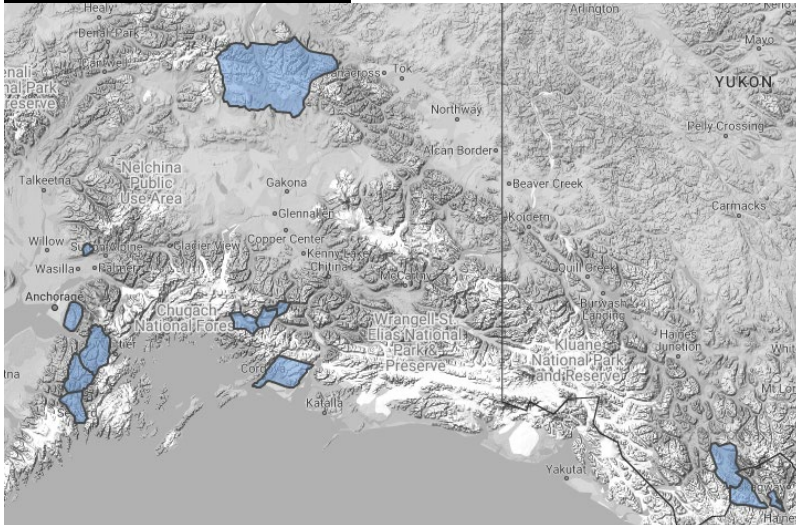
