Significant Issues:

2025 Riverwatch Operations

SEOC will deploy to the Kuskokwim Division on Wednesday April 30th, the Upper Yukon Division on Thursday May 1st, and the Middle Yukon Division on Wednesday May 7th, to commence the annual Riverwatch aerial surveillance of ice and river conditions during spring break-up.

The Divisions, staffed with SEOC Operators and National Weather Service (NWS) Hydrologists, will fly rivers as breakup proceeds providing local communities with real-time reports on river conditions and flood risk. Divisions will be immediately available should flooding occur to support local response.


