Significant Issues:

The SEOC Manager is in Juneau for a few days, planning and coordinating with Tlingit & Haida and the City & Borough of Juneau in preparation for potential glacier outburst flooding in the late summer. The planning sessions will also include other partners from local, state and federal agencies and businesses.

The last Kuskokwim (Kusko) Division community call was held today. The Kusko Division has a scheduled deployment date for this week on Wednesday, followed by the Upper Yukon Division team on Thursday. The Middle Yukon Division team is anticipated to deploy Wednesday, May 7th. The last Yukon community call is scheduled for tomorrow morning. National Weather Service and community reports continue to hold to predicted patterns of ice break up, with Upper and Lower Yukon Divisions as well as the Kusko Division showing signs of an early break up with low potential risk of flooding. The Middle Yukon Division's trend is yet to be determined as break up is slower due to the above-average snow accumulated in the region this winter and early spring.


