Prolonged Southerly Flow Into Coastal Kuskokwim Delta through Sat, including increased winds and water levels higher than normal highest tide line. Coastal erosion and flooding of low lying areas is possible.

Special Weather Statement: Interior

Temps rapidly rising into the 80s through the week above season normals by late week. **Flood Watch: North Slope**

Possible flooding from snowmelt in effect from Friday Morning through Tuesday afternoon Special Weather Statement: Southern Alaska Peninsula
