Significant Issues:

Wildland fire season in Alaska continues with slowing growth overnight. Cooler weather patterns have aided suppression efforts across the state with warmer temps anticipated by the weekend. Personnel in the SEOC continue to facilitate numerous cooperative meetings with fire teams, Mass Care and local jurisdictional agencies. SEOC DivSup in the Denali Borough will be demobilizing today.

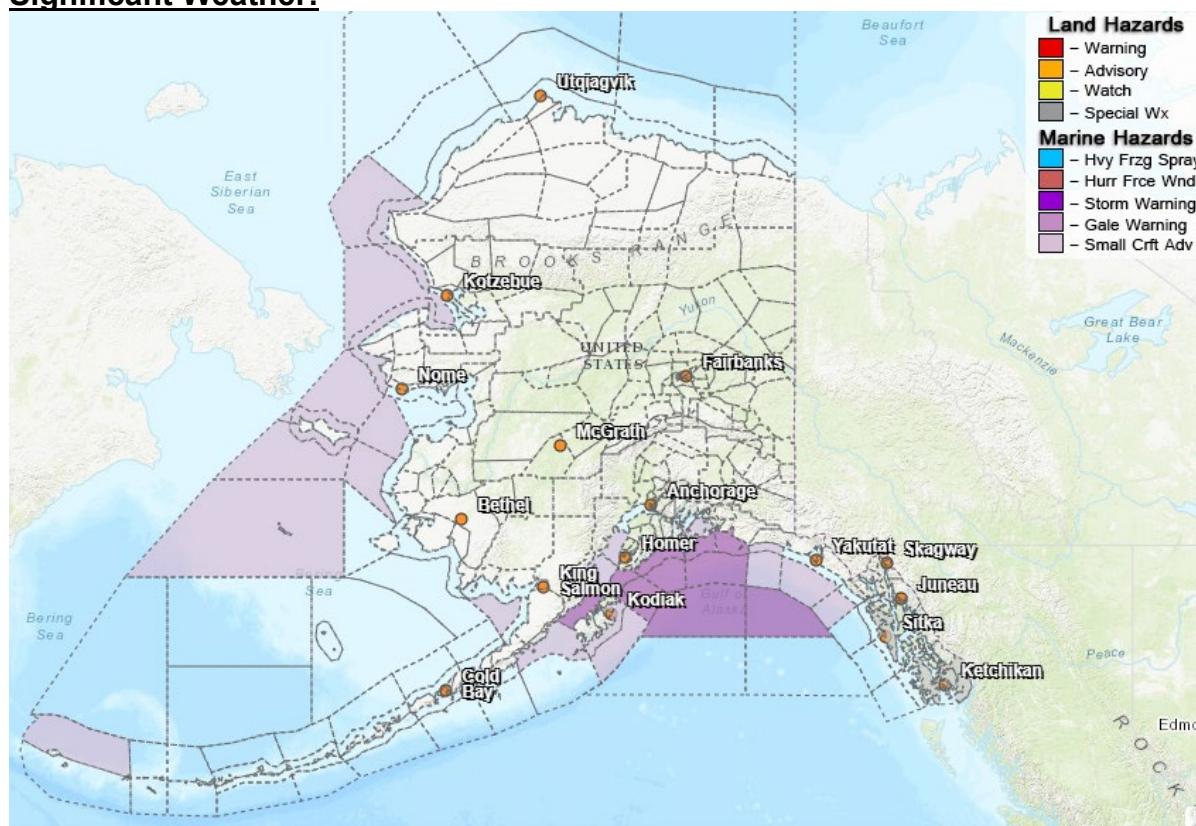
