Significant Issues:

Statewide Wildland Fires – State at Fire Preparedness Level 4

SEOC is implementing the Governor's declaration of disaster in the Denali Borough for Individual Assistance and Temporary Housing as the priority. The Denali Borough is currently reporting 63 destroyed structures of which 14 are primary residences.

SEOC is actively working to provide information from impacted businesses for consideration of a SBA declaration for business disruption due to fires. SEOC has a Community/SBA call scheduled for Wednesday.



High Surf Advisory: **Southern Seward Peninsula Coast; Eastern Norton Sound and Nulato Hills; Yukon Delta Coast –** minor coastal erosion expected. Water levels of 3-4 feet above the normal high tide line, except 4-6 feet above the normal high tide line for Stebbins, Unalakleet, Shaktoolik, Koyuk, Elim and Golovin until 4AM Wednesday.

High Surf Advisory: **Bering Strait Coast –** minor coastal erosion expected. Water levels of 2 to 3 feet above he normal high tide line until 10am Wednesday.
