Statewide Wildland Fires – State at Fire Preparedness Level 3

Cooler and wetter weather patterns continue to aid firefighters. Preparedness Level reduced to 3 as fire behavior calms. SEOC continues to facilitate Mass Care needs, community meetings and distribution of information/messaging.

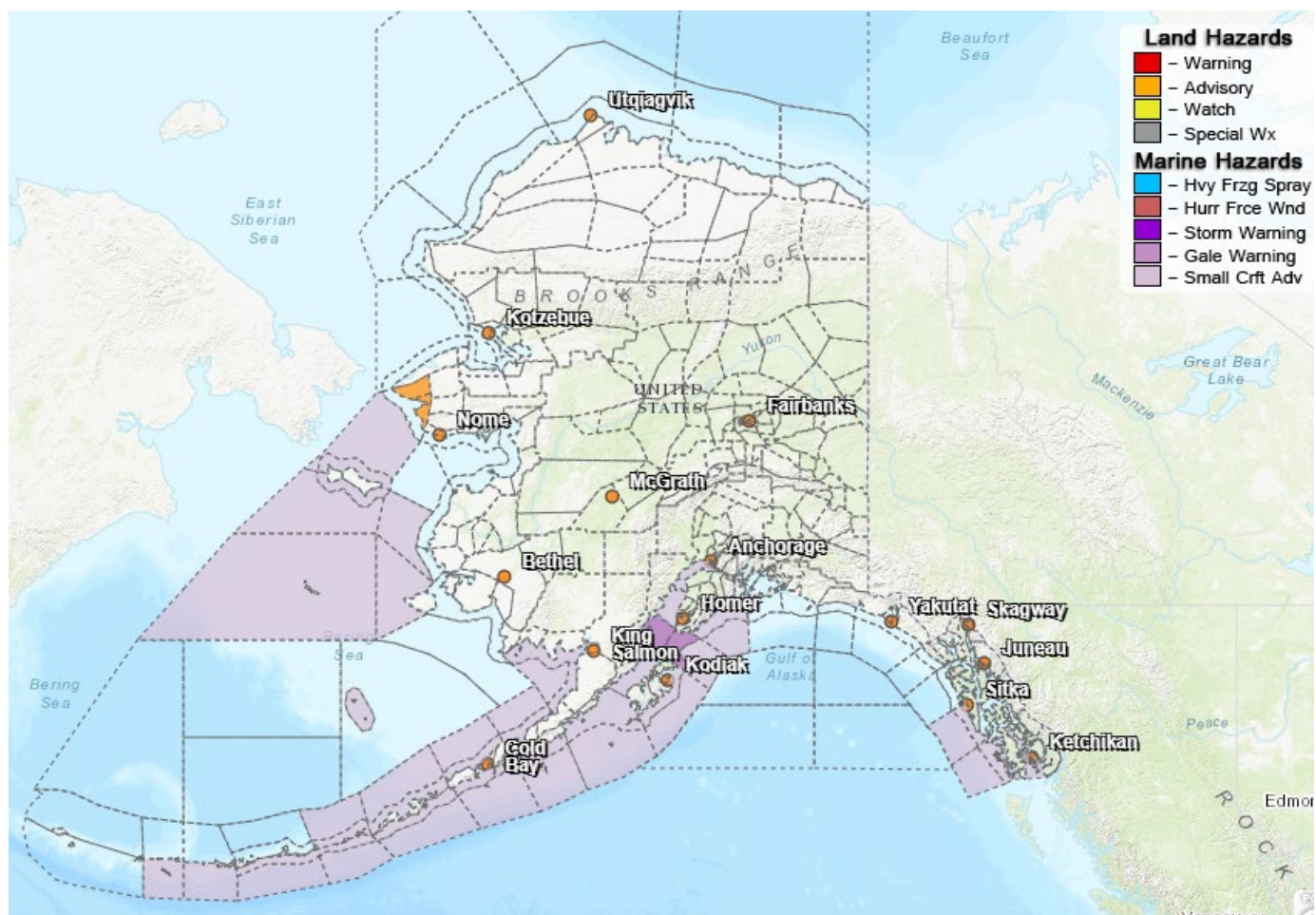
