Significant Issues:

SEOC Preparedness Level 1 – Routine Operations

With the reduction in fire activity and evacuations statewide, and closure of shelters, SEOC has moved down to Preparedness Level 1 – Routine Operations.

State Disaster – Denali Borough Fires

SECO continues implementation of state disaster programs for Individual Assistance, Temporary Housing, Public Assistance for the fires in the Denali Borough. SEOC is working through the Small Business Administration application process for impacted businesses in the area of the fires.

Silver Alert – Palmer

Alaska State Troopers and SEOC issued a Silver Alert on Friday for a vulnerable adult, Myra Lanthier, age 72 of Palmer. She was last heard from on July 17, 2025, at around 8:30 am. Earthquake – Sand Point – Magnitude 6.2

A magnitude 6.2 earthquake occurred at 1428 hrs AKDT on Sunday approximately 50 miles from Sand Point. SEOC contacted the community and conferred with the Alaska State Seismologist, and there were no reports of damages or injuries. This earthquake is in the same area as last Wednesday's magnitude 7.3 earthquake that generated a Tsunami Warning but also did no damage.


