Significant Issues:

Tsunami Warning – Off the east coast of Kamchatka Russia – 8.8 Earthquake

- The National Tsunami Warning Center (NTWC) issued a Tsunami Advisory for Western Aleutians including Pribilof Islands at 1535 AKDT yesterday for a magnitude 8.0 earthquake off the east coast of Kamchatka Russia.
- SEOC executed the Tsunami Advisory Checklist, making positive contact with emergency managers in the coastal hazard areas and coordinating information across the state. SEOC and Ops staff recalled.
- NTWC issued and updated magnitude approx. 45 min after the initial report from 8.0 to 8.8 with confirmation of tsunami wave and revised alert areas. SEOC activated Tsunami Warning Checklist, with communities in the alert zones being contacted through various channels.
- Pacific Tsunami Warning Center (PTWC) places all coastline in Hawaii under Tsunami Warning shortly after.
- NTWC and PTWC issue multiple messages with updates to alert areas, updated observations and forecast information. Coastal areas at risk extended to California
- SEOC staff remained in close contact with highest risk communities in proximity to epicenter of the earthquake.
- Multiple aftershocks along the Ring of Fire coastline have been detected, as strong as 6.9 with no additional Tsunami alerts as a result.
- The largest wave detection for this event being reported in the US was Kahului, Maui @ 5.7 ft.
- NTWC reduced alert levels for western Aleutian Islands at 22:22 AKDT to Advisory Levels from Warning Levels. See info graphic below for more details
- SEOC staff remains engaged ongoing changes and notifications to impacted communities.
- All alerts (warning, advisory, and watch) for Alaskan communities have been cancelled as of 10:22 AKDT this morning.

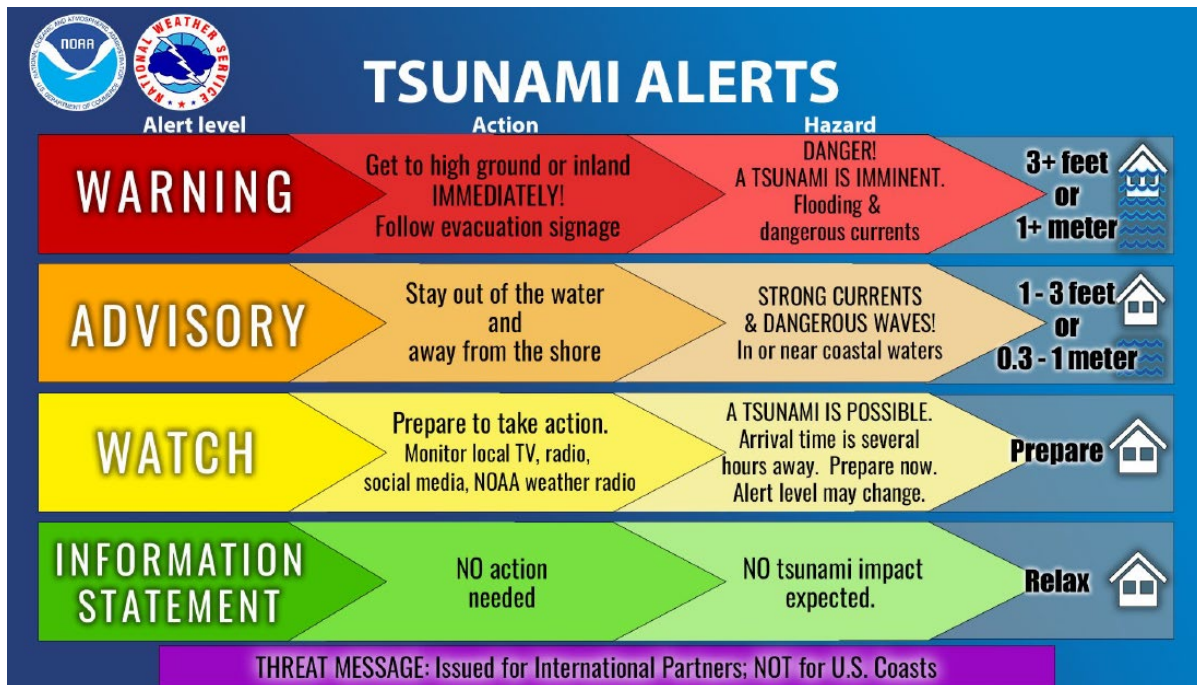

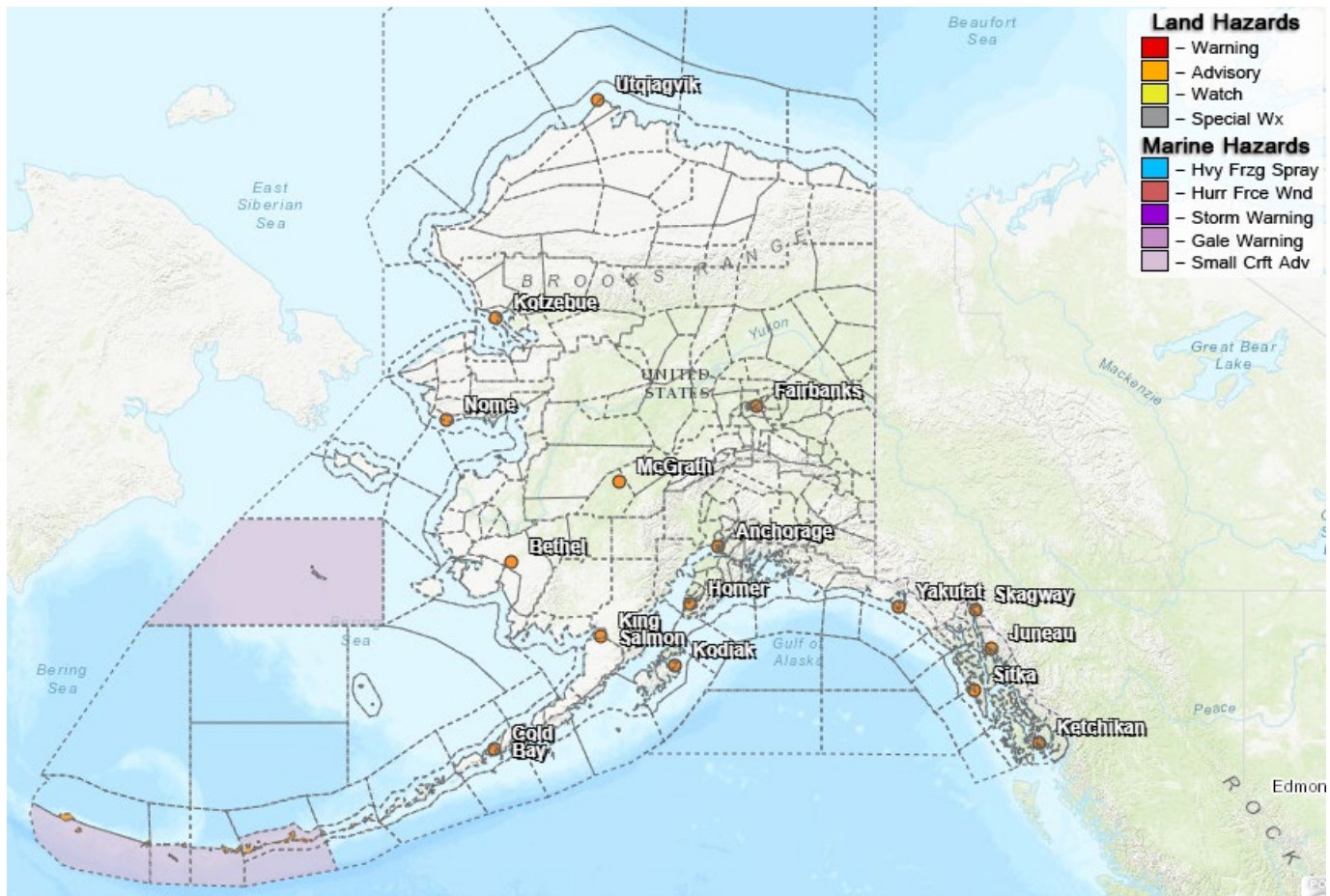
