

Red Flag Warning - Northern Copper Valley; Western Copper Valley; Central Copper Valley; Southern Copper Valley; Tok Cutoff. Remains in effect from 1 PM this afternoon to 9 PM AKDT this evening for hot dry and windy conditions for the central Copper River Basin.

Dense Fog Advisory – Eastern Chichagof Island. In effect until 10 AM AKDT this morning.

Wind Advisory – Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp. In effect from 7 AM to 7 PM AKDT Thursday. South winds 20-30 mph with gusts up to 50 mph expected.
