## **Significant Issues:**

#### **Juneau Glacial Outburst Flood**

CBJ/Tlingit-Haida will conduct damage assessments today, which will be used by the Unified Command, Red Cross, and the State to coordinate assistance. SEOC provided the Unified Command with complete public information on the State Individual Assistance disaster program. SEOC has a Branch Director in Juneau and a Division Supervisor supporting the CBJ/Tlingit-Haida Unified Command.

The Mass Care Group remains active in support of unmet needs. SEOC resource ordered ADEC today to assist the Juneau Unified Command with four teams to survey for potential flood contamination. FEMA IMAT will demobilize tomorrow. All Flood Watches and Warnings have been canceled.

#### **Presidential Summit**

The SEOC Response Manager met with the USSS and JBER EOC and will be embedded with them tomorrow as Summit Branch Director. A Division Supervisor is assigned to the Municipality of Anchorage EOC. SEOC will conduct full multi-agency operations from its continuity site to support local impacts and manage any consequences from the Presidential Summit. SEOC will operate in Unified Command with the Alaska Department of Public Safety.


