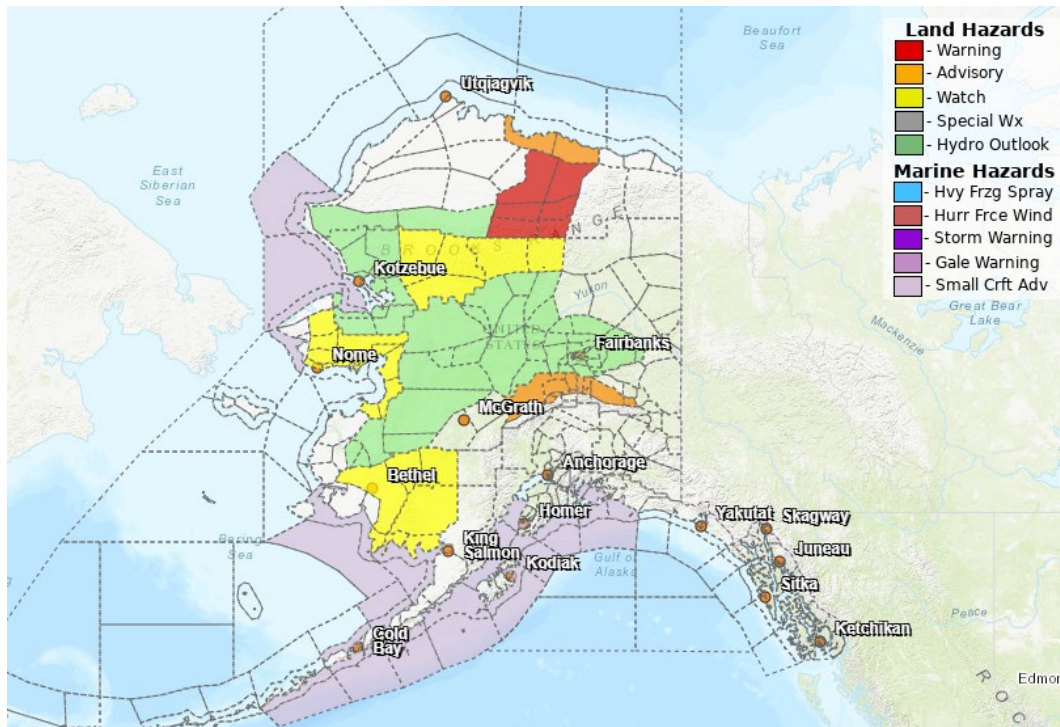

Wind Advisory - **Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp**- In effect from noon to 10 PM Tues.

Wind Advisory - **Northern Denali Borough; Delta Junction; Eastern Alaska Range North of Trims Camp**- In effect till 4 AM AKDT Weds.

Coastal Flooding Advisory - **Kuskokwim Delta Coast and Nunivak Island**. In effect from 11 AM to 6 PM AKDT Monday.

Flood Watch - **Kuskokwim Valley West; Kuskokwim Valley East; Interior Kuskokwim Delta; Northern Bristol Bay Coast; Inland Bristol Bay**. In effect from Monday morning through Thursday morning.
