**Significant Issues:**

**The State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) remains at Preparedness Level 2 —** Heightened Awareness for flooding response and recovery. There are no Flood Warnings in effect statewide at this time.

**Yukon–Koyukuk REAA — Allakaket**

- An Alaska Division of Forestry & Fire Protection crew is deployed and conducting dewatering operations, flood-debris support, and disaster supply distribution.
- The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation is deploying spill responders to assist with spill cleanup and provide environmental technical assistance.
- SEOC has activated the State Public Assistance (PA) and Individual Assistance (IA) programs.

**Northwest Arctic Borough — Kobuk**

- Lutheran Disaster Services, the American Red Cross, Food Bank of Alaska, The Salvation Army, NANA, and donated air carriers are delivering food, water, and preparedness supplies to support the community following flood-related service disruptions.

**Nikolski — M5.1 & M5.0 Aftershocks**

- Nikolski experienced magnitude 5.1 and 5.0 aftershocks yesterday following Wednesday's M6.0 earthquake. No damage or injuries were reported.

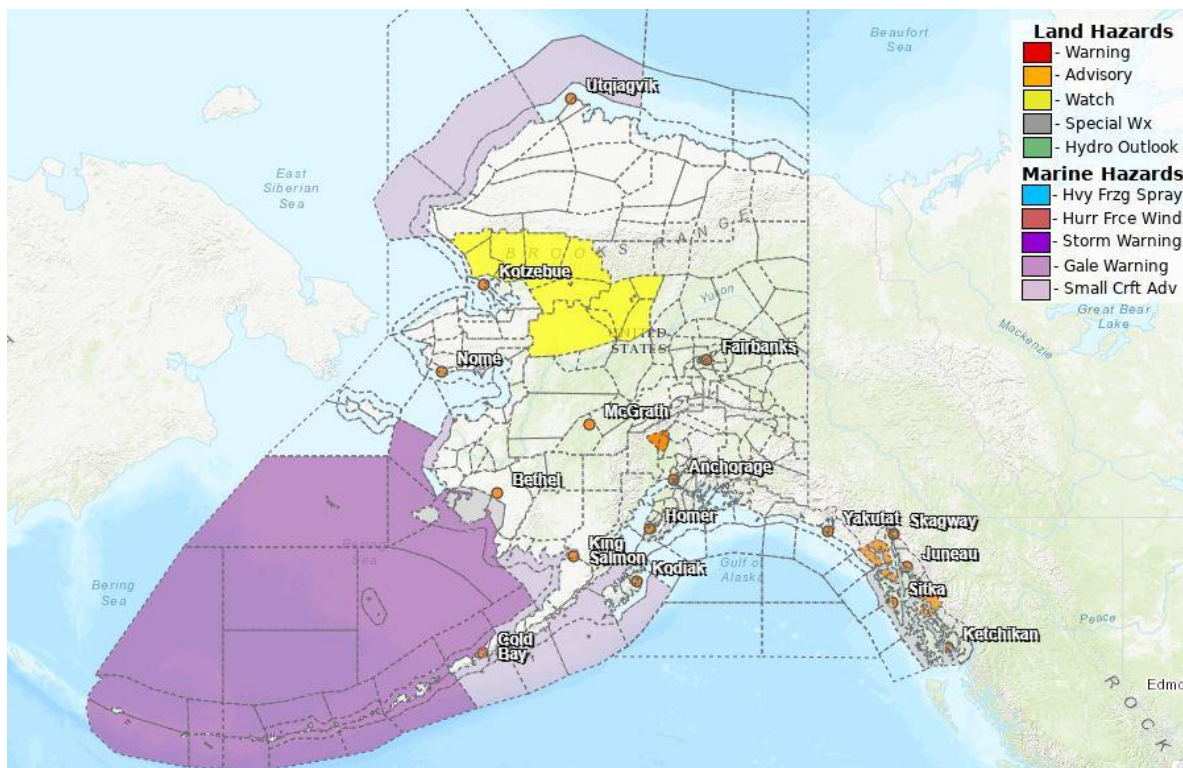
