Significant Issues:

Juneau GLOF- Yesterday the National Weather Service identified a second release of the Suicide Basin Glacial Lake. A flood warning was issued for the Mendenhall Lake and River with an actual observed crest of 9.6ft at 7:30PM Monday evening. The flood warning has since been cancelled and the Mendenhall river levels are dropping; NWS continues to monitor the basin and flood potential. Southeast Weather- A strong storm has moved into southeast Alaska with heavy rains and wind, leading to a areal flood warning yesterday in Ketchikan (that has now been cancelled) and concerns for landslides throughout the area. The SEOC is in regular contact with southeast communities.


