# **Significant Issues:**

### **Elfin Cove:**

Division of Forestry crew and DOT&PF crew continue to make good progress on the debris removal. Trees involved in the landslide/blow down are old growth large spruce trees, estimated at up to 4ft in diameter and 150ft tall. The boardwalk has been cleared with the exception of one section still being blocked by a large tree, expected to be cleared soon. Crews have assisted homeowners with providing and setting up tarps to impacted structures and will continue to assist with impacted residential structures in Gull Cove.

SEOC Div Sup remains onsite to continue to facilitate community needs.


