**SEOC Preparedness Level: 4 — Major Incident Response**. The Alaska SEOC is fully engaged in two coastal storms. The Oct 8–9 system produced significant flooding; the second, Ex-Typhoon Halong, caused catastrophic impacts across the Y-K Delta, with widespread inundation, damaged infrastructure, and homes displaced from foundations. The Governor's Oct 9 disaster declaration was expanded Oct 12 to cover all impacted jurisdictions; Public Assistance, Individual Assistance, and Temporary Housing are activated.

With search and rescue complete and accountability reports received, priorities have shifted to life-sustainment and comprehensive situational awareness: sustaining shelters with food, water, medical support, and other basic needs; and validating damage to community lifelines and residences that cannot be safely reoccupied. Branch Directors are operating from Bethel and Kotzebue with Alaska Organized Militia and Division of Forestry & Fire Protection personnel deployed. Rotary- and fixed-wing aircraft staged in Bethel are moving supplies, responders, and survivors; the Bethel Armory is open as a shelter, with additional options on standby in coordination with AVCP and YKHC.

The SEOC Mass Care Group is coordinating shelter support and early recovery; The Salvation Army is managing VOAD/donations efforts; the American Red Cross has teams on the ground with additional personnel inbound; and World Central Kitchen is providing meals to survivors. Mutual aid has been requested through EMAC.


