Typhoon Halong – West Coast Storm:

The Alaska State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) is fully activated, coordinating with multiple response partners, is supporting the aerial evacuation of hundreds of disaster survivors from the hardest-hit Y-K Delta communities to a shelter in Anchorage. This operation is being conducted in close coordination with individual survivors, their home communities, the Alaska Association of Village Council Presidents, and the Yukon-Kuskokwim Health Corporation. Additional evacuations will occur in the coming days based on survivor needs.

The Governor's October 9 disaster declaration was expanded on October 12 to include all affected jurisdictions. Public Assistance (PA), Individual Assistance (IA), and Temporary Housing (TH) programs are active. Residents may apply for State of Alaska Individual Assistance by calling 1-844-445-7131 or 907-427-7962, Monday through Friday, 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or online at <https://ready.alaska.gov/IA>.

The Bethel National Guard Armory is serving as an interim shelter and logistics hub, staging and deploying disaster supplies, equipment, and personnel to affected communities throughout the Y-K Delta and the Northwest Arctic Borough. In Nome, additional Alaska Organized Militia members are on State Active Duty supporting recovery operations. Sheltering capacity in Bethel is maintained in coordination with AVCP and YKHC, with supplemental sites on standby as needed.

Mass care and voluntary agency coordination remain active. SEOC's Mass Care Group coordinates shelter support and early recovery. Salvation Army manages VOAD/donations operations. American Red Cross has teams on the ground with additional personnel inbound. World Central Kitchen provides meals for survivors.

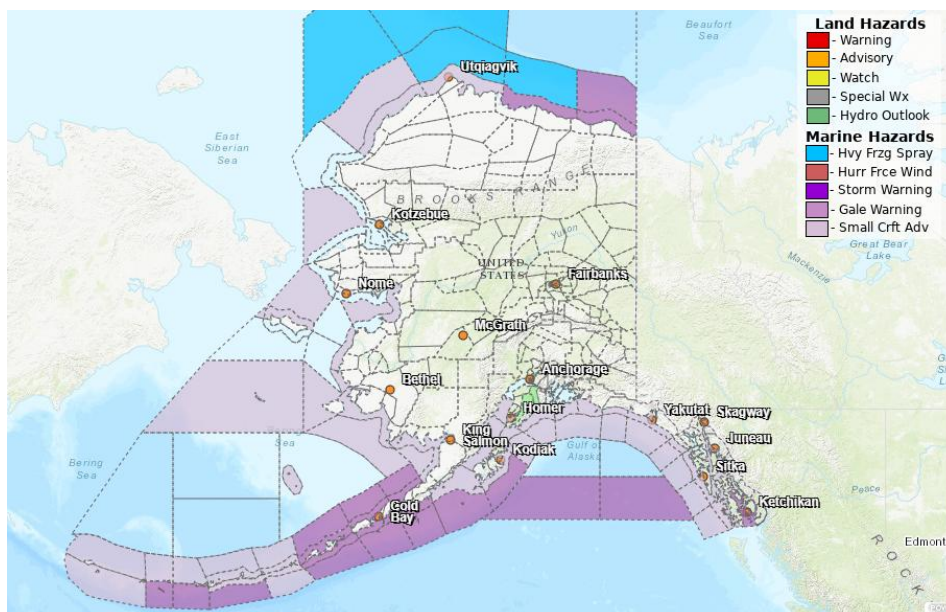
