The Alaska State Emergency Operations Center (SEOC) is fully activated and, as part of a multi-agency operation with multiple response partners, is supporting the aerial evacuation of hundreds of disaster survivors from the hardest-hit Y–K Delta communities to shelters in Anchorage, with air transportation provided by the U.S. Coast Guard and the Alaska Air National Guard. Upon arrival at JBER, the Army, Alaska National Guard, State Defense Force, and Anchorage School District (ASD) are working in tandem to transport survivors to community shelters. Shelters are open at the Egan and the Alaska Airlines Center, where the American Red Cross, The Salvation Army, AK VOAD partners, and the Alaska Native Tribal Health Consortium (ANTHC) are coordinating support.

The Governor's October 9 disaster declaration was expanded on October 12 to include all affected jurisdictions. Public Assistance (PA), Individual Assistance (IA), and Temporary Housing (TH) programs are active. 
